Player Code of Conduct

Peaks Youth Hockey Association (PYHA) believes strongly in the values of teamwork, sportsmanship, and leadership. Players should understand that hockey is a team game and they should strive to be team players. As such, respect, support, and encouragement of your teammates is expected at all times. PYHA follows the Zero Tolerance Policy laid out by USA Hockey. All PYHA players should be committed to following code of conduct.

1. Respect the game of hockey and always play to have fun and develop.
2. Respect your teammates, coaches, opponents, and officials.
3. Do your best to be a team player; encourage good team play.
4. Learn teamwork, sportsmanship, and discipline.
5. Learn the rules and play by them.
6. Arrive and be dressed on time for practices and games.
7. Give 100% effort at each practice and game and don't be afraid to make a mistake.
8. Act appropriately during practices and games.
9. No swearing, abusive language or gestures, racially insensitive remarks, damage to property or belongings on the bench, in the rink, or at any team function.
10. No lashing out at any official no matter what the call is (or is not). Coaches will handle all matters pertaining to officials.
11. Never deliberately jeopardize the safety and well being of a teammate, opponent, coach, or official. Understand that there is no place for fighting, violent or overly aggressive play in hockey, where the obvious intent is to injure or harm another person.
12. Anyone who receives a penalty will skate directly to the penalty box.
13. Respect locker rooms as private areas for players, coaches, and officials. Electronic devices with recording or photo capabilities are not allowed to be used in any locker room or bathroom.
14. The use of social media to embarrass or harass a teammate, coach, opponent, or another team will not be tolerated, and will result in the player's immediate removal from the Provo Predators Youth Hockey program.
15. Coaches are volunteering their time to teach you and your teammates; respect them and accept their authority.
16. Learn from your coaches, practice hard, play smart, and have fun.

All players participating in PYHA programs commit to uphold the Peaks Youth Hockey Player Code of Conduct. Violation of this Code of Conduct may result in loss of ice time, suspension for part of or all of a game, removal from PYHA facilities, or even removal from the Provo Predators Youth Hockey program.
