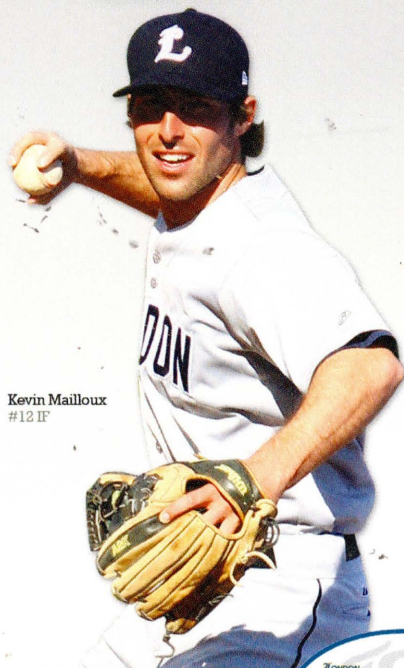
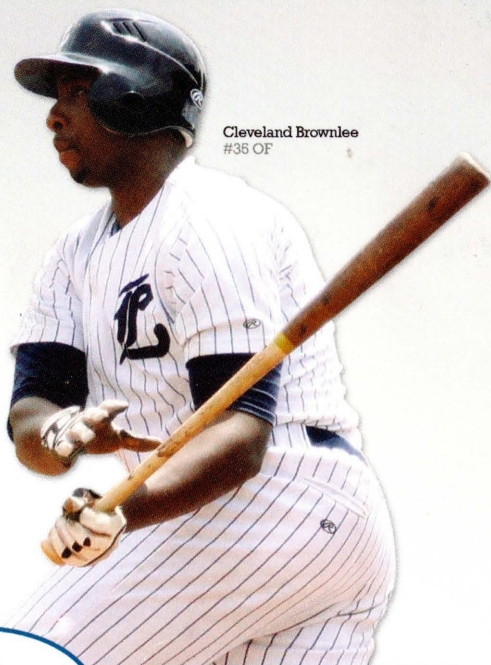

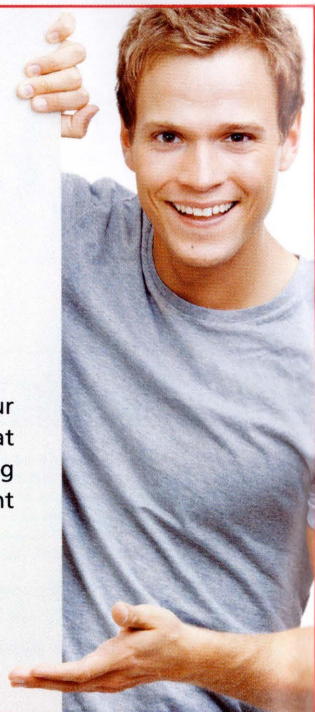

MANAGER'S MESSAGE

The start of another London Majors Baseball season is upon us, what an exciting time of the year. This will be my 6th season leading the Boys of Summer as co-owner, general manager and field manager. There have been lots of changes with our team and the league for the 2011 season!

2010 definitely had some very exciting moments. Beating Kitchener in Game 7 of the quarter finals and advancing to the semi-finals against Barrie, having both Ryan LaPensee (Arizona D'Backs) and Zack Breault (Blue Jays) sign pro contracts with MLB Teams, Andy St. Gelais (P) dominating the league by winning Rookie of the Year and 1st Team All Star, Cleveland Brownlee (OF) leading the IBL in homeruns and Allan Cattryse (2nd Base) being named 1st Team All Star were memories I won't forget. Last years team finished the season at 0.500 (18-18), good for 5th place and only 3 games behind 3rd place.

The IBL now has only 8 teams since the Guelph Royals have taken a leave of absence for this season. The players from Guelph have moved to various teams throughout the league. I recruited 2 players from Guelph, Chris Stewart (OF) and Ryan Hart (P), both all star caliber players in our League.

The busiest part of my job is as GM of the Majors and this means recruiting top caliber players for our team. Some of the big signings during the off season include: Kevin Mailloux (IF) who retired from pro ball with the Seattle Mariners, Jordi Amargos (P) from the Dominican Republic, who played a few years in the Tampa Bay Rays organization, Tyler Graham (C) a former IBL all star from Stratford, Rory Young (P) a former Houston Astros draft pick from BC, Josh Kennedy (OF) who was an all star at the University of Guelph, Cuban born player, Julio Estrada (resident of London) and Mike Arsenault (P) from Oshawa. In addition we have added some good young local talent such as Mackenzie Harrison (C) currently at Chipola College in Florida (Jose Bautista is an alumni of Chipola), Adam Paish (P) and Shawn Robinson (IF), both all stars for the University of Western Ontario (UWO), and Jon Fitzsimmons (P) at Canisius University in Buffalo. Some key returning players from the 2010 team are Chris Chambers (1st Base), Alan Cattryse (2nd Base), Paul Lytwynec (3rd Base), Steve Froese (IF), Mike Mitro (P), Josh Palmer (P), and Matt Brennan (P).

We have continued to build on our loyal fan base with lots of fun game day events and activities in keeping with the family atmosphere at the park. Some of our exciting games this year are Sifton's Pack the Park Day, with proceeds going to Sunshine Foundation, Nothers' LDBA Day at the Park (free for all of minor baseball teams), our annual July 1st Game (with fireworks after the game), and our Kids School Day Get Away Game.

I am thankful for our volunteers and staff that help make the experience at the ball park enjoyable for the best fans in the IBL. Anna Gladysz, our Marketing Manager has been hard at work getting local businesses to partner with our team and raising awareness in our local community.

I continue to preach three main things to all of our players; **HARDWORK, DEDICATION & RESPECT**, we believe this is the foundation for a successful organization.

Dear Players and Fans:


Congratulations to all in attendance at today's Home Opener and may the skies be sunny, the bats hot and the refreshments icy cold.

GOLDIE AND TECUMSEHS PUT LONDON ON BASEBALL MAP

The London connection to the Canadian Baseball Hall of Fame in St. Marys has been long- standing and it may be extended if a bid to honour Fred Goldsmith and the 1877 London Tecumsehs is successful.

Goldsmith's grandson John Castle of Colorado Springs, Colorado, will be nominating the team and its star pitcher who put London on the baseball map some 124 years ago when they won the International Association championship right here at Labatt Park. Goldsmith led the Tecumsehs to a 5-2 victory over the Pittsburgh Alleghenys to become the first Canadian team to ever win a professional championship.

1877 was a banner year for Goldie and the London team. They took on all comers and defeated most of them including arch rival Guelph Maple Leafs with pitcher and brewery magnate George Sleeman at the helm. During an 80-game schedule in which they won 47, lost 26 and tied seven, the Tecumsehs played teams and hall of famers with such historic names as the Chicago White Stockings (Cubs) with Cap Anson and Philadelphia Athletics with Connie Mack. Other opponents included St. Louis Greys (Browns), Boston and Cincinnati both called the Red Stockings, and clubs representing Detroit, Cleveland, Milwaukee, Buffalo, Columbus, Toronto, Rochester and Brooklyn, N.Y. among others.

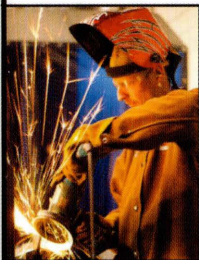
Oilman Jake Englehart bankrolled the Tecs while Harry Gorman, an editor with the old Advertiser was the manager. It was Gorman who brought Goldsmith to town from New Haven, Conn in 1876 and all Goldie did was dazzle the opposition with his new pitch he had invented called a twister or curve ball.

In the years 1876 through '78 Goldie won 136 games, lost 54 and tied nine. The Tecumsehs won three Canadian championships and never lost a game in 14 meetings with Sleeman's Guelph side. Goldie would go on to win three National League championships with the Chicago White Stockings.

London is well represented in the Canadian Hall with George (Mooney) Gibson, Frank Colman, Tim Burgess, Peter Hardy, Don McDougall and Peter Widdrington enshrined. You could add London-born Paul Quantrill, onetime Majors pitcher Bill Slack and London resident Jim Fanning. And because Sleeman and Guelph were admitted to the Hall in 1999 you can see that John Castle has a valid argument for adding Goldie and the Tecumsehs.

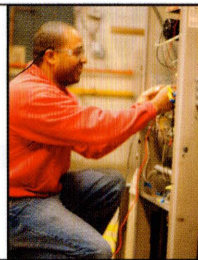

LONDON MAJORS 2011 SEASON PREVIEWS

After watching the London Majors struggle to an 18-18 record during the 2010 Intercounty Baseball League regular season – and a second round playoff defeat to the Barrie Baycats – Roop Chanderdat decided changes had to be made.

Chanderdat, the Majors' field manager, general manager and co-owner along with Scott Dart, says he has been working hard this off-season to give London fans a team that can excite them in 2011.

"I am always thinking it is going to be easier. And it could be, but I hate leaving things to chance. It just seems busier than ever," says Chanderdat. "I don't know if it is trying to be perfect, or trying to

do everything, but I always see the potential. You don't want to lose out on potential. Other than my first year in 2006 when I didn't know what I was doing, just seems like I have made a million calls this off-season."

Chanderdat says the team's .500 record in 2010 pushed him to re-evaluate the entire roster. The results, according to Chanderdat, could result in some excited fans at Labatt Park this season.

"After a .500 season with some success in the playoffs, you have to evaluate everyone, including yourself. You want to bring guys back, but I always tell them, if I can improve a position, then I will," Chanderdat says. "We are under the radar I think. If we can gel as a team, we can be there with Barrie, Brantford, Kitchener. If everything comes together, the fans could see a really good team. I am excited about this year. It looks very competitive to me."

That team will include returning players Chris Chambers (.262 AVG, 21 RBI, 52 TB) at first base and all-star Allan Cattrysse (.323 AVG, 21 RBI, 62 TB) at second.

The consistency at first and second will stand in contrast to the changes at shortstop and third base.

"Shortstop has seen a big improvement. Kevin Mailloux is coming in. He's a great talent, a huge pick up for us. He has been with the Seattle Mariners organization. He was a first-team all-star in high A ball. So he has come here for an opportunity that is good for him," Chanderdat says. "If things are right with him, he could be MVP. He can play everywhere on the infield, but short is where he will start."

The Majors' hopes at third base will be filled with the promise of young talent.

"At third base we have Paul Lytwenyk. He is still a junior age player, but the priority is us. He's a London kid; he has won with the Badgers, won with Western, where he is playing right now. We have another kid named Shawn Robinson, who was a first-team all-start with the Western team at shortstop," Chanderdat says. "And we have Steve Froese, who played for me last year in a utility role. They will all get a shot at third base and the main backup utility role."

In the outfield, Chris Stewart, formerly of the Guelph Royals, will get a shot in center field while Cuban export Julio Estrada and Josh Kennedy, who played recently for the University of Guelph, will get an opportunity to claim the right field spot.

While there is uncertainty at center and right field, Cleveland Brownlee returns to provide stability in left field and the clubhouse.

"Cleveland Brownlee (.277 AVG, 24 RBI, 69 TB) is back. He's the homerun leader (with nine). He gives us that big bat. I have never seen a guy hit a ball farther, and I have been here a long time," Chanderdat says. "But also, he understands everything. He's mature. He knows the game. Baseball at a higher level has passed him by from an age perspective, not from a talent perspective. I want him to assert himself as a leader."



Roop has been All Star manager twice in the last 5 years and has taken the team to the championship finals twice in the last 5 years.

Behind the plate is another spot Chanderdat is quick to point to as seeing a huge upgrade.

"We are looking for a huge improvement at catcher. Last year we had a first-team all-star who hurt his knee at the College World Series and we were always working around that all season. This year we have Tyler Graham. In 2008, I coached the all-star team in Toronto and he played for the Stratford Nationals. He said one day he would love to play for London. Well someday is this year. He will hopefully be our everyday catcher," Chanderdat says. "Another catcher we have is Mackenzie Harrison. He's a local kid, played in the Badger program. He is going to college in Florida. He's young and someone we can build on. So he will play a role."

On the pitching mound, Chanderdat says the team will have to work hard to replace last year's top pitcher, and league rookie of the year, Andy St. Gelais (7-3, 2.30 ERA, 58 SO).

"Andy will play in the Can-Am league. But if things don't work out, he will come back. But without Andy, the big addition is Ryan Hart. He's the second guy I got from Guelph Royals. In 2008 when Josh Palmer was 8-0, got pitcher of the year, all the awards, Ryan Hart was 10-0," Chanderdat says. "Ryan had a high ERA, Josh had a low ERA. That Guelph team could hit. In 2009 he went 6-0. Last year he fell off and was 3-4. I still think he's got it. He's a workhorse. He has battled Brantford, Barrie, he knows what it takes."

Ryan McGorman is another player Chanderdat says he has big hopes for. "In 2008 when we went to the finals, in game five, he pitched a one-hitter against Brantford. He hasn't played baseball in a couple years, got married, had a kid. So he is coming back. If he can find it again he could be a real asset."

Also returning for the Majors are Mike Mitro (18.00 ERA, 0-1, 8 IP) and Josh Palmer (3.60 ERA, 1-2, 26 SO). Craig Bate (1-2, 5.60 ERA, 24 SO) was scheduled to return, however, he broke his ankle playing hockey and so his return date is unclear.

The Majors also have signed Adam Paish, formerly the Ontario University Athletic Association player of the year; Jordy Armargos, from the Dominican Republic and a former member of the Tampa Bay Rays organization; Jon Fitzsimmons, out of Canisius University, in Buffalo; and Matt Brennan.

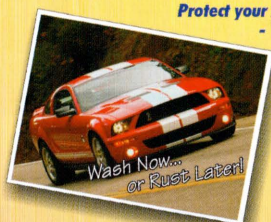
