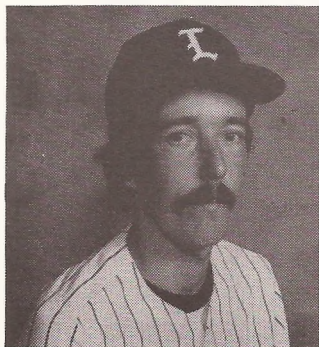
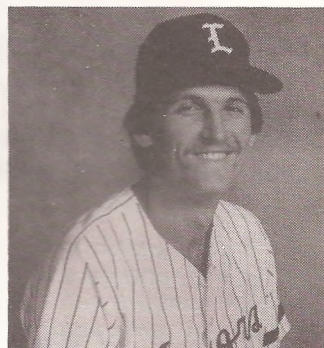
## **A. McKay** 2B.

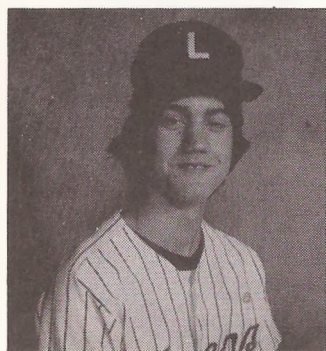
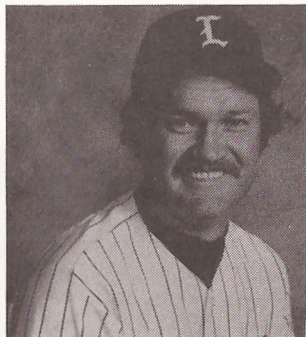


## DEAN HIGDON 3B. & S.S.

## DAVE COWDRY

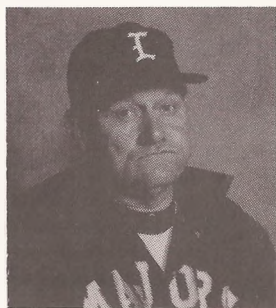

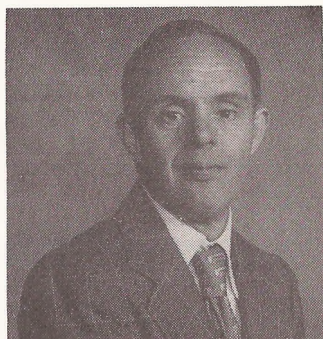


**BOB HAMMOND** Trainer

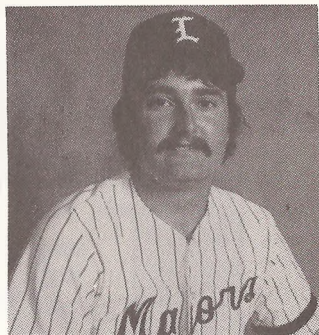

## **DAN THORNER** First Base

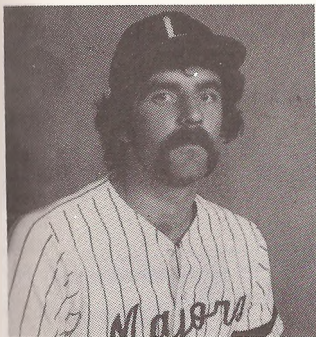

## **BRUCE GRAY** Pitcher

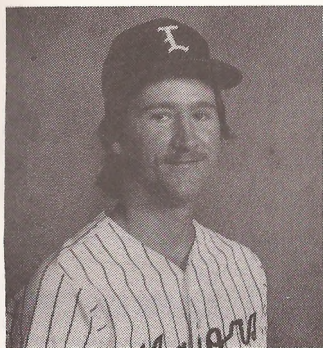

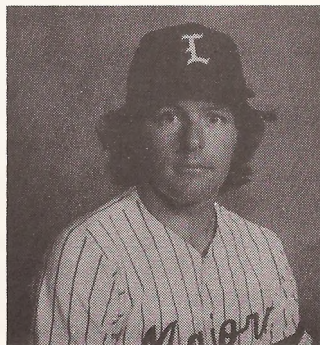


**RANDY MERCER** Outfielder

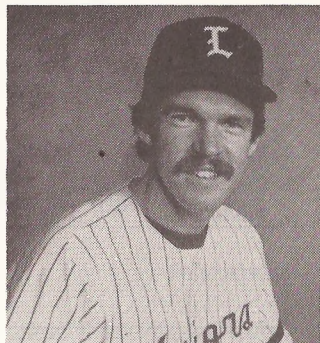
