
Roop Chanderdat GM / Field Manager's Message

Baseball, more than any other sport in our country, is a game rooted in the past and in tradition. London Majors Baseball has been your community team since 1925. While the team is starting their 87th season on the road in Guelph, there's still a lot of action inside Labatt Park getting ready for Home Opener on Mother's Day, Sunday, May 13.

As many baseball fans in London may have heard last fall, the Majors have been preparing to overcome quite a few obstacles to not only survive but thrive as an Intercounty Baseball League (IBL) franchise. With the City of London decision to allow a second baseball team at Labatt Park, they have lost first rights to park scheduling, their clubhouse, their concessions and even a few of their players.


As I have learned over the years, baseball survives its changes with its traditions still intact. With 87 years of London Majors Baseball comes a lot of history and tradition, and the team is going back to their roots. In between spring training workouts, the finishing touches are being put on the new Majors' clubhouse, the Roy McKay Clubhouse, a heritage building that has been used by the team on and off for 75 years. With a little bit of hard work, dedication, and respect, it's starting to feel like home again.

Most of the Majors' favourite traditions are celebrated year after year, not only because they make being a fan that much more enjoyable but also because one of the biggest pleasures for Roop Chanderdat and Scott Dart (co-owners) is giving back to the community they grew up in. Some of their favourite memories and events to look forward to this year include Opening Day on Mother's Day (May 13), LDBA Day offered for free to all kids that play minor ball in partnership with Nothers (June 15), Oldtimers' Day with special guests from the 1948 Majors who won the National Baseball Congress North American Championship (June 24), Canada Day Fireworks (July 1), Pack the Park partnered with Sifton with proceeds going to Sunshine Foundation (July 15), kids running the bases during all the games, autograph sessions after the games, and getting to provide players an opportunity to develop to the next level.

Some of the new players recruited by Chanderdat (also GM and Field Manager) include Eric Cordova (RHP) from Los Angeles, CA who played for Benedict College and was named first team All-SIAC the last two years, Jason Schneider (IF/RHP) from Windsor, ON who won the 2011 Canadian Junior Championships, Richard Corrente (LHP) from Chatham, ON playing at Erie Community College, Rolando De Los Santos Wilson, an import utility player from the Dominican Republic, Derrick Strzalkowski (C/1B) from London, ON playing at Grand Valley State, Chris Stewart (OF/2B) from Brantford, ON with previous IBL experience with the Guelph Royals, Byron Reichstein (OF) is a St. Thomas, ON native who won the Baseball Ontario Player of the Year Award in 2011 currently playing at Texarkana College, and Parris Austin (OF) from Hattiesburg, MS drafted by the NY Mets playing for the Western Major Baseball League in 2011.

As new traditions are built and old ones re-created, one thing is a constant, London Majors Baseball will continue to provide family-friendly entertainment for years to come.

The Major Earned His Stars and His Stripes

BRUCE HUFF'S OFF THE CUFF

The Major was holding court around the batting cage at Oscelola Stadium, the Houston Astros spring training facility where he was a guest instructor at a fantasy baseball camp. He was regaling the assembled horde with stories as only he could tell.

"Yessir, that bullet entered my helmet right about here," he projected, holding his hands up and pointing to a place near his left ear.

"It travelled around my helmet and exited on the other side, right about here," he explained.

It's a story Ralph Houk had told many times over. He was a major in the Rangers Unit of the United States army and his near-death experience came during the famous Battle of the Bulge near Bastogne, Belgium in the Ardennes during the winter of December 1944 and January 1945. It was a defining time as the Allies pushed across Europe in their quest to defeat Hiltler and the Germans.

What the Major didn't say was the Battle of the Bulge was the bloodiest encounter the Americans suffered with an estimated 89,000 casulties including 19,000 killed. He also didn't mention the important participation by our Canadian forces in that region.

For his combat service Houk was awarded a bronze star, purple heart and silver star. As a player Houk was a catcher with the Yankees from 1947-1954 serving as backup to Yogi Berra, with a lifetime batting average of .272.

He would become the manager of the Yankees succeeding Casey Stengel in 1961. All told he would be involved in six World Series with the Bombers, twice as manager (1961 and 1963). He also managed the Detroit Tigers from 1974-78 and the Boston Red Sox 1981-84. His lifetime totals read 3,157 games, 1,619 victories aand 1,531 losses.

The Major wasn't finished with his session around the batting cage. "Ya know, I had a .500 World Series batting average," he offered. "I had one hit in two at -bats. I was in the bullpen (located in the outfield) when I got the call from Casey. He told me to get down to the dugout right away.

"At Yankee Stadium there was a bit of step up when you opened the bullpen door. Well, I stepped up and I was so excited, I banged my head on the top of the gate opening. Somehow I made it to the bench, dizzy as hell.

"Casey sent me to the plate and I made contact although I didn't see the ball drop. It went for a single and I made the scoresheet." (The year was 1947 when the Yankees beat the Brooklyn Dodgers in 7 games).

This writer was taking batting practice while Houk was enthralling his audience. Then I heard: "I don't care how many hits ya get Huff, I ain't gonna sign ya. Yer too damned old!" All punctuated with a high-pitched guffaw and menacing zit of chew.

The Major died on July 2010 at age 90 at his home in Winter Haven, Florida. (Bruce Huff is a retired sports writer and founder of the London Sports Hall of Fame)

New Majors ready to light up Labatt Park

The London Majors pitching staff put up good numbers in the Intercounty Baseball League last season, but that hasn't stopped general manager Roop Chanderdat from adding some depth to his rotation as the team prepares for 2012.

Jordi Amargos led the way last year with seven wins in 11 games and an ERA under 3.00. He started 10 of those games and finished with a 7-2 record.

Josh Palmer led the team in ERA, posting an impressive 2.37 in eight games on route to a 3-1 season. As a team, the Majors finished with a .406 ERA, good for second in the IBL behind only the Barrie Baycats.

One of the new names joining the rotation this season so far is American Eric Cordova, who is currently wrapping up his college career at Benedict College in South Carolina.

Another is one of the Majors' more intriguing additions this off-season, Canadian righty and recently released Cincinnati Reds farmhand Mike Henry. The 22-year-old from Sombra, near Sarnia, came home to Ontario after spending four years bouncing around the Reds' rookie affiliates.

"Last year even though our pitching was so good, we didn't have good depth and this year I think we've improved but it's a matter of those guys stepping up," Chanderdat said. "(Henry's) going to be a top of the order guy. Anytime there's a chance to win, I'll probably use (Henry). So I'll use him out of the bullpen a little bit but I'll also use him as a starter."


With a 90 mph fastball in his arsenal, Henry should be fun to watch at Labatt Park this season. He was drafted out of high school by the Reds in the 48th round in 2007 after developing through minor baseball with the Sarnia Braves and the Intercounty Terriers.

"I've been home since July and it's a little bit different than what I'm used to," said Henry, who is hoping to get back on scouts' radars as soon as possible.

"From what I understand, (the Majors) run a pretty good program and they've got good players on the team," Henry added. "It just seemed like a good place to start, being so close to home."

With some proven IBL pitchers already in place, Henry said he's excited to join the Majors' staff and bring along with him some of the experience he's gained as a prospect in the United States.

"At the start I was pretty naïve ... but I came to realize I was pretty far behind a lot of the older guys coming out of college," Henry said about moving south in 2007. "It was definitely a big learning curve. Unfortunately it just didn't work out with the Reds so we'll see what happens.
