GAME NOTES: These two teams split this past weekend's doubleheader, and will close the M2 regular season as part of a pro indoor soccer doubleheader with the MASL Baltimore Blast, who will host Utica City FC at 6 p.m. Orlando will be playing for a playoff seed, as with the win, they will be seeded sixth overall for next weekend's playoffs in Wichita. With a loss, the Iowa Raptors will be the sixth seed and Orlando the seventh seed in the eight-team post season. Last Saturday, Orlando never trailed after Rodrigo Kauffman gave Atletico a 2-1 lead just over two minutes into the second quarter. On three different occasions after that, Baltimore was able to pull within one goal but never did find the equalizer. Jordan Travers made it a 6-5 game with 3:28 to play, but Orlando closed out the game with two scores, including one against a sixth attacker, and the true back breaker, a shorthanded tally by Eduardo Cruz with 1:52 left in the fourth. Juan Reyes had two goals and one assist for Orlando, while Kaufman and Cruz finished with two goals each. Charly Vargas added two assists. Erik Lorent had two goals for Baltimore, who outshot Orlando 35-27. On Sunday, it was just as tight. Baltimore never trailed after taking a 3-2 lead with just over a minute left in the first period from Michael Bernstein. Orlando forged tie scores on two occasions after that, but never did lead the rest of the way. Orlando outshot Baltimore 34-30. Joe Stefoi had two goals and two assists to lead the Arsenal attack, while Brayde Wise had a hat trick. Kauffman had a hat trick for Orlando. This will be the third game of the season between the two East Division foes.
