 - a. Need help with acquiring Sponsors for the AHL tournament this summer. **The deadline to get sponsors will be at the end of May** so that sponsorship items can be purchased.
- IX. Rink Upgrades - Dan and Bart have taken the lead on the rink projects
 - a. **Leveling the surface:** rink was self leveled **DONE**
 - b. **Tile installation:** Tile will be installed once the surface is repaired **DONE**
 - c. **Lighting:** Work off the structure and run conduits. Have a separate switch for lights. Kenny will be doing the work. AHL will need to buy the materials/supplies. (Lights have been ordered. Bart is going to test the brightness of them. If we cannot acquire the specs for spacing, it may be trial and error) (Austin is having footers for steel metal poles fabricated through his company, free of charge)
 - d. **Metal Piping:** behind the nets need to be installed (Received, not installed)
 - e. **Mesh protective netting:** A plan has been decided on the best way to protect the business next door. At the moment, it will be designed like a backstop in baseball. The netting will be less on the other side since there is nothing beyond the rink. Netting can be hung once poles and footers are available. We may try to wrap it like a normal rink and get bigger poles near the edge of property and attach netting to block the business. We will know more tomorrow.
