

## **B.C. PREMIER BASEBALL LEAGUE SCHOLARSHIP POLICY**

The BCPBL has established a policy of awarding up to six scholarships annually to student athletes pursuing a post-secondary education in Canada. The scholarships will range from \$250 to \$1500 and up to a total of \$5000 in scholarships will be awarded annually.

**To be eligible to apply for a scholarship, the student athlete must meet the following conditions:**

1. A scholarship for a player graduating from high school requires that the applicant must have completed **both** their grade 11 and 12 years of their high school in British Columbia and played a minimum of **one** year in the BCPBL.
2. High school applicants must have a GPA of **2.75** or greater in their core subjects; English, Math, Science and Social Studies to qualify for a scholarship.
3. A scholarship for a college player requires the applicant to have played a **minimum** of one year in the CCBC or another Canadian baseball program.
4. Players in college can apply for a scholarship **annually** until their graduation.
5. Applicants must attend or plan to attend a recognized post secondary educational institution in **Canada** and must be on the active baseball roster of the institution as of March 1<sup>st</sup> to qualify for a scholarship.
6. College applicants must successfully complete the **fall and spring** semester taking a minimum of 9 units with a minimum GPA of **2.75** in those courses taken to receive a scholarship.

The scholarship applications will be reviewed by the Executive Management Committee (EMC) of the BCPBL and the scholarships will be granted based on the academic assessment of the candidates. The high school and post secondary GPA will be used as the determining factor when deciding on candidates of equal baseball ability. The scholarship recipients will be announced in November after all applicants have been contacted on the status of their application. Payment of the scholarship will be made in **March** upon receipt that the applicant is academically eligible. Only players who are academically eligible for participation in the spring championship baseball schedule will receive their scholarship.

To apply for a scholarship, applicants must complete a **BCPBL Scholarship Application Form** and provide a certified copy of their high school transcript or a certified copy of their fall and spring semester college transcript to the BCPBL league office. **Deadline for applications is July 15<sup>th</sup>. The BCPBL reserves the right to decide if any or all of the scholarships will be awarded in any given year.**
