SHAMROCKS END THE WLA DROUGHT

On Friday, September 11, 2015, the Victoria Shamrocks sent the Q Centre into a state of frenzy by defeating the Peterborough Lakers 12-6 and hoisting the Mann Cup. The gleaming trophy that Scott Ranger held high was a beautiful sight for all Shamrocks fans, but interestingly, that trophy was not the "real" Mann Cup.

Sir Donald Mann, a notable railway contractor, donated the original Mann Cup in 1910. It was originally a challenge trophy, but was handed over to the Canadian Lacrosse Association in 1925. From that year forward, the champions of the Western Canada and Eastern Canada battled for the Mann Cup, with the host alternating from east to west every year. This format still exists to this day. Eventually, the original trophy was locked away in the Canadian Lacrosse Hall of Fame, and a replica is presented to the Mann Cup champions every year. The original Mann Cup in made of solid gold.

Ultimately, what the Mann Cup symbolizes is more important than any physical trophy. Considered the "holy grail" of Canadian lacrosse, the Mann Cup represents the countless hours of practice and dedication that go into becoming an elite team. Winning the Mann Cup is an incredible experience, but it can mean different things for different people.

For Shamrocks general manager Chris Welch, the difficulty of winning the Mann Cup is what makes it such a unique experience. "I think one of the things that makes the Mann Cup so special is how incredibly difficult it is to win," says Welch. "It is such an intense experience. You have to win three best of seven series in about a six-week period. The final series is hard enough by itself, seven games in nine nights. I don't think there's anything else like it in sports." Winning such a difficult series obviously brings a lot of pride as well. "On a personal note, it's an honour for me to be part of this proud and historic team," says Welch. "To have worked to bring a national championship to this great city has been a highlight in my life"

Shamrocks head coach Bob Heyes has won multiple Mann Cup championships in his playing and coaching career, but the 2015 Mann Cup stands out as a very emotional experience. "There were so many emotions experienced as we hoisted the Mann Cup in September," says Heyes. "Sheer happiness and joy for everyone involved with the organization, from players, management, trainers, my fellow coaches and of course all of our families. There was also a sense of pride for getting the job done and becoming part of that Shamrock championship legacy." After losing in the two previous Mann Cup championships, the 2015 win felt particularly good for Heyes. "The biggest emotion I experienced was relief, after the previous two years, it was great to say...We Are The Champions," added Heyes.

For two-time Mann Cup champion and Shamrocks defender Tyler Burton, the amount of work that is required to win a Mann Cup is what makes it such a rewarding experience. "The Mann Cup is the first major championship I won in lacrosse, and to be able to win it a second time in the city I now call home is something very special to me," says Burton. "To win a Mann Cup means a lot of blood, sweat and tears. After being so close so many times, winning really ties everything together." Part of what makes the Mann Cup so special to Burton is that for him, it is a family experience. "It is also very special to me, because I got to share the experience with my parents both times I have won the cup," says Burton. "The sacrifices they made for me growing up throughout my lacrosse career gave me the opportunities to win such championships as this. I owe everything to my family."

For over one hundred years, young men's blood, sweat and tears have gone into winning Mann Cup championships. This year the Mann Cup will be played in Ontario, where the Shamrocks have never been able to win a Mann Cup. This represents a huge challenge for the Shamrocks, but after all, winning the Mann Cup isn't supposed to be easy.

SUPERFAN GETS HIS RING

If there is one person that embodies the spirit of the Victoria Shamrocks, it is "Superfan" Jody Rice. He can be spotted at many local sporting events passionately cheering on Victoria's teams, but his relationship with the Shamrocks is truly unique.



Born with cerebral palsy, Rice never had the opportunity to play sports, but the passion and devotion that he puts into being a Superfan makes it seem as though he is a Shamrock himself. He first discovered the excitement of

Shamrocks lacrosse in 1979, when he saw the highlights of the Shamrocks 1979 Mann Cup championship on the



news. Seeing the fervor and excitement of the players and fans celebrating the victory made him want to get involved in supporting the local team. In 1980, Rice attended his first Shamrocks game, and since then, he has been a diehard fan through thick and thin. While Rice loves the speed and intensity of the sport, the entire experience and tradition of Shamrocks lacrosse is what makes his relationship to the team so special. "My favourite part is the atmosphere; I love the people here," says Rice. "The tradition of the Shamrocks goes back to 1950. There are some people that still come here from 1950's. So it's really cool to see all those people at the games."

Rice has had the pleasure of witnessing six Shamrocks Mann Cup championships in his 37 years as a fan, but the championship in 2015 was particularly significant for him. "It was just incredible when they won last year," says Rice. "It had been 10 years. Also, that series was so tough to win. And, of course I remember the previous two disappointments... So it was amazing to see them finally get over the hump." Five months after the Mann Cup win, the Shamrocks organization made sure that Rice would never forget the 2015 championship by presenting him with an authentic 2015 Mann Cup championship ring. Rice has been a close friend of Shamrocks president and governor Jim Hartshorne since 1980, going back to the days when Hartshorne owned the Victoria Cougars hockey club. The ring was a token of Hartshorne's thanks for 37 years of friendship and support, and to show just how important Rice is to the team. " It was an incredible feeling, getting this ring," says Rice. "It's an incredible honour, and it's something that I'll never forget."

It is clear that the Shamrocks mean a lot to Rice, but the feeling is mutual. "The team, the players, the coaching staff all know him as a committed and unwavering fan – a true Superfan" says Hartshorne of Rice. "When you look at all the challenges Jody has to deal with, it's just such an inspiration to see what he does to support us." Rice remembers a time when the Shamrocks were not as successful as they have been in recent years. "For me, it's doing my part to keep these teams in town," says Rice. "From '85 to about '95, the franchise really struggled. I recall when they were the Victoria Payless, and they almost folded. There were just five to six hundred people in a 5000-seat building. And I'm just doing my part as a season ticket holder." While Rice has been a devoted Superfan of other many other Victoria-based teams, the Shamrocks have a very special place in his heart. "It's the best atmosphere in town, and it's the best run organization in town," says Rice.

With another WLA season beginning, Rice looks for big things from the Shamrocks in 2016. "Most of the core from last year's team is coming back, and I think they're still hungry," says Rice. "I keep in touch with a lot of the guys throughout the winter, and I keep reminding them that they have to come back, because they still haven't completed the mission. In spite of all the great teams and players that the organization has had over 66 years, they have never won the Mann Cup in Ontario. And if these guys come back and do it, they will be remembered forever."

As in every other season for the past 37 years, Rice will come to the Q Centre with a smile on his face, ready to cheer his heart out for the Shamrocks. The only difference this year will be a green glow coming from his left hand, a symbol of his undying devotion and support for the team that is proud to call him their very own "Superfan".

SHARROCKS 2015 SEASON IN REVIEW By Janice Huckin

The Shamrocks came into the 2015 season coming off a second consecutive, 6-game Mann Cup series loss. Looking to reverse the trend, the off-season saw the team acquire a couple of topnotch goaltenders following the retirement of Matt Flindell. Aaron Bold, a former Jr. Shamrock, and Matt Roik, who previously played with the Rocks, came in to play alongside second-year player Cody Hagedorn. While Bold had outside commitments that would limit him to just 5 regular season games, Roik and Hagedorn were up to the task. The Shamrocks also added some toughness in Rory Smith (the same Rory Smith that Shamrocks fans previously loved to hate) and Steve Priolo. Cory Conway returned to the team, and Jesse King became a full time player.

Hopes were high, but the start to the regular season was less than auspicious as the Shamrocks lost the first two games of the season. To make matters worse, both losses came against their island rivals, the Nanaimo Timbermen. The T'Men won the Shamrocks' home opener at the Q Centre by an 8-6 margin, and in the return date came away with a 12-9 victory. That was definitely a wake-up call. The Shamrocks would not lose another game until July 10 when they fell 13-11 to the Coguitlam Adanacs, and once again on the July 23, at the hands of the New Westminster Salmonbellies. The Shamrocks would finish the regular season atop the standings with a 14-4 record. Incidentally, Nanaimo would win only one more game during the season.

Corey Small and Rhys Duch lead the way offensively throughout the regular season. Small played in all 18 regular season games and amassed 79 points on 33 goals and 46 assists. Neck and neck all the way, Duch finished with 75 points in 17 games played. Conway and King were right behind, with 64 and 74 points respectively. Cody Hagedorn finished with a 6-2 record between the pipes. Aaron Bold won four of his five starts, and Matt Roik got into seven regular season games.

Heading into the WLA playoffs, the Shamrocks were the first seed with 28 points, followed by New Westminster with 24. Langley, Maple Ridge and Burnaby tied with 18 points. The Burnaby Lakers were the odd team out based on head-tohead competition, so the Maple Ridge Burrards had the dubious honour of a first round matchup against the powerhouse Shamrocks.

The Burrards were no match. The Shamrocks took the series in four games by a cumulative score of 51-23. Game 2 erupted in the usual shenanigans that occur when the Burrards feel threatened, but it was to no avail. The Rocks dominated, and went on to face the New Westminster Salmonbellies in the league final. Once again, the Rocks swept, which gave them a lengthy rest before starting the Mann Cup on home floor at the Q Centre.

Having a long break can be a double-edged sword. Is it better to rest those nagging injuries? Or does a team get stale with no game-action during a long stretch? Well, the Shamrocks wrapped up the final on August 21 and the Mann Cup final would start on September 4, so fans had two weeks to wait for the answer. Fortunately for the Shamrocks, the Major Series Lacrosse League final between the defending champion Six Nations Chiefs and the Peterborough Lakers went long. The Lakers emerged victorious, with Game 7 win on a Monday evening. That Wednesday, they were on their way to Victoria, and the series began on the Friday.

The teams split the first four games with Victoria winning games 1 and 3, and Peterborough came up with victories in games 2 and 4. Wait a minute, haven't we seen this script before? The Shamrocks would not be denied, as they came up with a commanding 14-7 win in Game 5. This is when that rest really paid off, as the physicality of the series took a toll on the visitors. Despite a valiant effort in game 6, they fell by a 12-6 score, giving Victoria the 4-2 series win, and the celebration was on. Victoria held a 4-0 lead after 20 minutes, the Lakers battled back to 4-6 after two. but the Shamrocks dominated the final period, 6-2, which sent the Q Centre into pandemonium. This was not just the first Mann Cup for the Shamrocks since 2005; it was the first Mann Cup for a WLA team since 2005. Quite a drought!

Much is made of the offensive talent on the team but make no mistake, this was an entire team success from start to finish. When the snipers were shut down, speedsters like Karsen Leung and Tyler Hass picked up the slack. The defense and goaltending were solid, and gave the Shamrocks a chance to win every game. It was a fantastic season for the players and the fans. The Shamrocks sport the best fans in the league that have supported this team for so many years.

Can the Shamrocks do it again? Shamrocks GM Chris Welch and president Jim Hartshorne are

hard at work and have signed some of the core players from the previous couple of seasons, most notably Corey Small, Jesse King, Tyler Burton who was a dominant force in the faceoff circle all season, and goaltenders Cody Hagedorn and Matt Roik. Other recent signings are Ethan Garland, and local fan favourites Matt Yager and Chris Wardle. Despite having very few picks in the draft of junior graduates, they managed to

pick up some quality players. With many players playing in the NLL until mid to late May, fans may have to wait for the dust to settle to see the final roster come together. But there is one thing that fans can count on: the Shamrocks will likely be in the thick of things once again as the 2016 season begins.
