# 2018 SEASON OUTLOOK

When the Victoria Shamrocks begin their 69th season in franchise history, they'll have a much different look. Not only will they be wearing a newly designed jersey and logo, but it will be the start of a new era as Corey Small has moved back to Ontario.

Small will go down as one of the greatest to ever play for the Shamrocks and will be missed by the organization for not only his skill and leadership on the floor, but also his tremendous work within the community.

Shamrocks' GM Chris Welch understands that the loss of Small will be a very tough hole to fill, but he didn't sit back and play the pity card. Welcome to Victoria, Rob Hellyer. If you are unaware of the diminutive forward out of Lions Head, Ontario, he has put up 375 points for the Toronto Rock in his last four seasons. "He's a very mature young man and he expressed an interest early that he wanted to play out here," said Welch a few nights before his team opened up training camp. The 25-year-old put up 34 points in just nine games for Oakville last year in the MSL and has become one of the best right handers in lacrosse.

Youth and speed will be a big focus for Welch and Head Coach Bob Heyes, who will welcome a wonderful class of WLA rookies from BC, Alberta and Ontario. 2017 playoff hero Danny Smith was drafted 9th overall by Victoria and will look to pick up right where he left off. Zac Christianson was raised within the Shamrocks family and has been waiting for this moment for his entire life. The injection of young legs will also see the reigning RMJALL Defender of the Year, Brett Craig, and Transition Player of the Year, Derek Lloyd, coming to town.

With Tyler Burton taking some time off to get married this summer, Welch went out and

acquired Ryan Fournier to fill the role of draw man. Fournier was drafted by the Vancouver Stealth 12th overall and finished the year in Buffalo. He put up solid numbers in both Jr B and Sr B, so look for Coach Heyes to use him in multiple roles.

While youth will be very evident, there will be plenty of veteran leadership on the floor and inside the locker room. On the back end, Ben McCullough, Greg Harnett, and Matt Yager will be looked upon to anchor the defence in front of goalies Cody Hagedorn and Adam Shute.

Offensively, another new face will be that of Tyson Gibson who put up 110 points last year for the Brampton Jr A Excelsiors and has spent the school year down at Robert Morris along with Smith and Christianson. And of course, there's Cole Pickup. The former Jr Shamrocks' star was selected by the Shamrocks 4th overall and like his fellow Jr Rock's alumni, will now get to finally be a true Sr Shamrock. It'll help that there will be some familiar faces out there with them as former Jr Rocks, Chris Wardle, Casey Jackson and Jesse King are all taking their games to another level.

So while there will be some new faces and even a new look in 2018, the roots of the Shamrocks draw from an incredible local talent pool that continues to get better every year. "Good teams are getting better, so we had to keep up," said Welch. With the Mann Cup slated for the East this year, all seven WLA teams have been making strategic moves during the off-season to position themselves for another long summer.

For the Victoria Shamrocks, the next chapter has begun and it will no doubt be another rockin' summer inside The Q.

The partnership will equip all WLA teams with HeadCheck's concussion testing technology and allow the league to monitor compliance to their concussion protocol using a web-based dashboard. HeadCheck will run data analysis to supply the WLA with the necessary information to make player health and safety improvements.

"We want to make sure every player in our league is receiving proper concussion testing," said Paul Dal Monte, WLA Commissioner. "By working with HeadCheck, we will be able to raise the standard of testing across the league and make the WLA safer for our players."

"For a concussion protocol to be effective, it needs to be followed with strict compliance," said Harrison Brown, CEO of HeadCheck Health. "Our technology will improve testing procedures at the team level and oversight of compliance to the concussion protocol at the league level."

# VICTORIA SHAMROCKS ONE FAMILY



The Intermediate, Junior and Senior Shamrocks teams and associations have existed in our community for many years. Although all “Shamrocks” in name, the three were, in fact, very separate entities, operated by three independent societies.

On November 1, 2011, the Junior and Intermediate Associations merged into one entity under the “Junior Shamrocks Society”, which has operated as one ever since.

In November of 2014, the Senior Shamrocks General Manager, Chris Welch and the Junior Shamrocks Vice President, Ron Wood, sat down and began talking about how the two societies and teams could work closer together by means of a Partnership Agreement.

On March 19, 2017, an announcement was made by Society Presidents Jim Hartshorne of the Senior “A” Shamrocks and Ron Hampton of the Junior “A” Shamrocks, ratifying that Partnership Agreement.

This means that although we are still two separate entities, we will be working together in every way possible. This translates to coaching, player and personnel development, common branding, similar uniforms and merchandise as well as working together

on public events, equipment purchases and marketing and ticket sales.

It will also translate to a common style of play on the floor as explained by Senior “A” Shamrocks General Manager, Chris Welch, “When we call a player up from Junior”, said Welch, “he shouldn’t have to learn our systems. They should already be familiar to him. Under this Agreement, the three teams will work closely together to maintain similar styles of play.”

Prior to the Agreement coming into effect, the clubs enjoyed a positive working relationship as demonstrated by the fact that 15 of the 2016 Senior “A” Shamrocks previously played for the Intermediate or Junior Shamrocks, or both. This Agreement will only make that working relationship stronger. In the words of Junior Shamrocks President, Ron Hampton, “we are thrilled to be working closely with a first class organization like the Senior Shamrocks and outstanding individuals like Chris Welch and Jim Hartshorne.”

We have been Shamrocks at heart and now we are in partnership as well. By bringing both of these organizations under one partnership umbrella, both organizations can benefit from the excellent infrastructure that each possesses. We are all organizationally Shamrocks at heart and now we are family!

# THE VICTORIA SHAMROCKS ANNOUNCE THE SELECTION OF 7 PLAYERS AT THE WLA DRAFT

With the clock ticking at the 2018 WLA draft, the Victoria Shamrocks selected Cole Pickup at fourth overall. As Captain of the Jr. Shamrocks, Pickup played 80 regular season games over five seasons and accumulated 334 points with a scoring accuracy of 98%. He was called up to play five games with the Seniors last season, during which time he scored a total of 19 points.

During the second round selection, the Victoria Shamrocks selected Danny Smith at 9th overall which was the result of a trade sending Evan Messenger to Coquitlam for the pick. Smith was



called up last season to play with the Seniors, and he played in 9 playoff games including an end to end run in the final minute of the game that resulted in a goal, sending fans into a frenzy. He also had scored 51 points over the course of 50 games with the Jr. Shamrocks.



The Shamrocks selected Alec Molander from Comox as their 3rd pick, and 18th overall. Molander played with the Jr. Timbermen in 2017 where he had 68 points including 35 goals over the season.



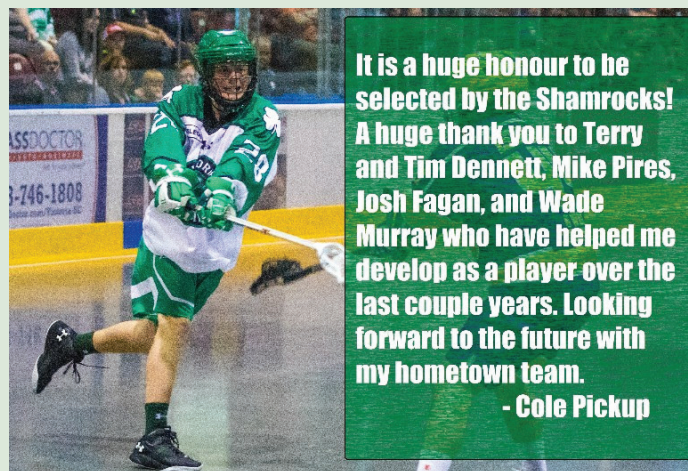
The 4th round saw the selection of another Jr. Shamrocks player, Zac Christianson at 25th overall. Christianson has played a total of 55

games over the past five seasons with the Jr. Shamrocks, scoring a total of 44 points.

The 39th pick in the 5th round went to Adam Golia from Mill Bay, and he has 56 points over four seasons with the Jr. Timbermen.

In rounds six and seven the Victoria Shamrocks selected Tommy Scanlan at 49th overall from the State of New York. He has a total of 40 points over 15 games last season with Coquitlam Adanacs. Reese Cullen from Saanichton, who played defense for the Jr. Shamrocks secured the last spot at 53rd overall.

Shamrocks General Manager Chris Welch commented, "Obviously we're very excited about what transpired tonight, but it's a little bittersweet because it came at a cost. Letting go of an outstanding young player like Evan Messenger was a very difficult decision because I have confidence that he will be a star in the WLA for many years to come. I thank him for his time with the Shamrocks and wish him and his family all the best. We are thrilled to welcome into the Shamrocks fold a number of bright young prospects who will fill out our local core for many years to come." Welch concluded, "All in all it was a great night for the Shamrocks."
