SHAMROCKS - 2014 SEASON IN REVIEW BY JANICE HUCKIN

2014 was season 65 for the WLA Shamrocks and they came off a stinging home floor Mann Cup loss as they dropped the 2013 series 4 games to 2 against the Six Nations Chiefs. Without a doubt they wanted to hit the floor running and get back to the national championship.

Despite some personnel changes, the team did exactly that. While Jeff Shattler departed for Ontario along with Matt Vinc, and Cory Conway did not return for the 2014 season, the Shamrocks had scoring leader Corey Small back in the line-up. Small had a season-ending injury in the 2013 playoffs, took the entire NLL season off to get back to the Shamrocks for the start of the season and he was raring to go. Rhys Duch committed to a full season and ultimately it was Small and Duch leading the team in scoring. The Rocks also had some great young talent in Jr. Shamrocks graduates Jesse King, Chris Wardle and goaltender Cody Hagedorn as well as Brandon Bull from the mainland. Team leader Scott Ranger returned and many of the defensive stalwarts returned as Ben McCullough, Tyler Burton, Jon and Greg Harnett held down that end of the floor with great contributions being made by transition players Karsen Leung and Tyler Hass to name a few.

Goaltending might have been a question in the minds of many fans as Matt Flindell finally took his place as a starter in the WLA after several years as a back-up. He was more than up to the challenge as the Shamrocks went 10 games into the season before their first loss.

Coming off a 13-13 tie in the season opener against their island rivals, the Nanaimo Timbermen in the hub city, the Shamrocks returned home to beat them 15-7 at the Q

Centre two days later. Flindell got the first 8 starts – something he has been doing early in the season for a while now - and the team was undefeated during that time. While there was a lot of scoring potential on the team, the defense was also solid allowing for some low-scoring wins along the way.

Rookie Cody Hagedorn got his first start on June 22 and came away with an 8-7 victory against the Maple Ridge Burrards. In fact, it would be the Burrards who would give the Rocks the most trouble as the season went along.

More help came along in the guise of one Dhane Smith, a talented two-way player out of Orangeville. His size and reach was a huge asset and, after a few games getting used to his new teammates, he seemed comfortable and added tremendously to the offense while not hurting the Shamrocks on the defensive side of the ball.

Midway through July, starting goaltender Matt Flindell went down with an injury but Hagedorn stepped up and the team didn't miss a beat. The Shamrocks had only 1 loss at home during the 2014 season and that was July 25 against the Burnaby Lakers.

They finished first in the league and took on the fourth place New Westminster Salmonbellies in round 1 of the playoffs. The 'Bellies have been a problem throughout the years for the Shamrocks but the green and white swept the series in 4 games, including a game 2 win on the mainland in which they scored 4 goals in 59 seconds to come from behind and squeak out a 13-12 victory.

On to round 2 and it was indeed the Maple Ridge Burrards facing the Shamrocks. With

Flindell again out with an injury, Cody Hagedorn got the first 3 starts, winning the first 2 games before dropping game 3 in overtime at home by an 11-9 score. The series was marred by penalties and brawls through the first 3 games but settled down somewhat for the remainder, which was eventually won by the Shamrocks 4 games to 1.

The Shamrocks had successfully defended their WLA title and won the right to advance to the Mann Cup, this year held in the home of the Ontario champions. Guess what – they had their chance at redemption as they would once again face the Six Nations Chiefs and their former teammate Shattler.

The Rocks dropped game 1 but came back to win the next two, both in overtime, similar to the 2013 series. Unfortunately they

were unable to maintain that momentum. The physicality of the series – OK, let's call it what it was – dirty play - took its toll, Flindell was once again felled by injury as the Chiefs rattled off the next 3 wins to once again take the series 4 games to 2.

Can the Shamrocks make it 3 years in a row with the Mann Cup again to be hosted by the WLA champion? Well, GM Chris Welch is certainly hoping so as he has made trades to obtain a couple of goaltenders. In the wake of Flindell's off-season retirement, Welch has obtained the rights to Matt Roik and Aaron Bold, both of whom will be familiar to local fans. Last year's rookies have a season under their collective belts and most of the offensive talent will be back in the fold. I say – three-peat!!!! And winning the Mann Cup for the first time in 10 years is definitely the goal.

TEN YEARS AND COUNTING

SHAMROCKS HOPE TO END THE WLA DROUGHT

Here we are again. The start of another WLA summer season and the question will be asked, will this be the year the West drought continues? This year marks the 10 year anniversary of the last time a WLA team hoisted the golden chalice. Every year people think it WILL be the year and as things play out it doesn't go according to plan. With the Mann Cup being played out west this year, there is once again in influx of eastern import players looking to help a west team break the streak. The Victoria Shamrocks are once again listed as favourites to represent the west for the third straight season. However just getting there is going to be challenge this year. Every year is a difficult year to come out of the west and there's a very large bullseye on the Island

As we've seen in years past, Victoria has been active during the off-season trying to lure whomever they can to spend a summer on the island wearing the green and white. There will be some familiar faces and some new ones. A few surprises and few givens. Being deep and talented on paper only gets you so far. Chemistry is integral and with everyone gunning for Victoria this year, there's not doubt head coach Bob Heyes will want as many of his players in town as early as possible. With the NLL season pushing further into May every year, he's going to half to rely on some of his younger and local talent to hold the fort until all the troops arrive.

Leading the way offensively this year will be fan favourites Rhys Duch and Corey Small but they'll be late arrivals while pulling duty with the Vancouver Stealth of the NLL. Jesse King who has been pegged as the future of the Shamrocks every since he was in junior is back but won't be in the line-up until he's all done at THE Ohio State. He's expected to give the Rocks an added weapon again this year and if all goes according to plan he'll finally get to play in a full Mann Cup series. In the mean time, look for Captain Scott Ranger to hold the fort. After taking the winter off from the NLL, Ranger is anxious to get back on the floor and lead the only way he knows how; full on. Chris Wardle and Mitch Jones will also

return this year to give Victoria more youth and speed on a very heavy loaded offence.

But that's not all. Those are just the returning players on the roster. Victoria was able to acquire the rights to Daryl Veltman from Coguitlam adding another potent lefty handed shooter to the roster. Veltman is a talented scorer that has been a thorn in the side of Victoria for the past few years as an Adanac. Local boy Cory Conway is back home after spending time with both Coguitlam and Nanaimo since his Jr Shamrock days ended. Victoria have been trying to get Conway back for the past couple years and it appears a chance to win a Mann Cup at home was too much for the pass first right-hander to pass up. But maybe the biggest returning player is one many Shamrock fans thought they'd never see playing out west again. Dan Dawson will come back to the city where he was an integral part of the 2005 Mann Cup winning team.

As the old sports cliche goes, offence may win games but defence wins championships. For Victoria their defence is going to have be even better this year than it was in 2014. Most of the big names are back from last year and will be looked up on d-coach Jordan Sundher to be even more impenetrable than before. Led by the the Harnetts, Greg and Jon, Victoria's back-end will be fast, aggressive and athletic. Fans will be happy to see Ryan Dilks, Tyler Burton, Ben McCullough, Bradley Kri and Bubba Westwood patrolling the floor. Rumours of a Rory Smith signing have been circling every since the Shamrocks acquired is western rights a couple years back and 2015 was to the be the year he pulled on the clover. There's your size and toughness but speed out of the back was always Victoria's strong point and that once again will be the case this year.

There probably isn't a better transition team in the west than Victoria's. What's even more crucial is the amount of local guys that make up the two-way game. Karsen Leung blossomed into a transition dynamo last year and will be looked upon to once again lead the

charge. Going both ways with Leung will be the likes of Matt Yager, Mike Pires, Tyler Hass, Ethan Garland and Mitch McLaren. Sometimes though you have to bring back a savvy vet to bring it all together and that could very well come in the form of the little water-bug Nolan Heavenor. Two years ago, Heavenor stepped away from the game to spend time with his family but the game pulled him back so expect him to share face-off duties with Burton and be the spark plug Shamrock fans remember.

There's depth all over the floor for Victoria and that's great but the biggest question could come in between the pipes. After last year's Mann Cup nobody would blame Victoria for giving young Cody Hagedorn the keys to crease. He stepped up huge when he was forced into action and was an unsung hero for the club. He could very well be the opening day starter but as we've disused with the O and D, Victoria has depth in net too. Victoria signed former Shamrock goalie Matt Roik to help with the goaltending duties and will be a great second option for Victoria for the time being. The golden goose though could be

the return of Aaron Bold. The Victoria native hasn't played on the island in a very long time and it's been long time coming for his return. Bold is one of the top goalies in all of lacrosse right now and if he can commit to Victoria they will once again have a legit top level goalie between the pipes. Bold has given Victoria a five game minimum but complications with his personal life could affect that.

It's clear, Victoria is once again doing all they can to be the western rep and host of the Mann Cup but with so many moving parts it could take a while for this club to come together. The WLA will be as tight as ever with the likes of Langley, New West and Burnaby also putting in off-season work to keep up with high-spending Shamrocks. Don't count out Nanaimo, Maple Ridge or Coquitlam either. It's a long way to September and you haven't booked your ticket to the big dance until you've won eight play-off games. So let the games begin and the war on the floor continue. The fastest game on two feet is back for another summer and it's about time somebody from the west puts an end to the Evil Empire's reign of terror.

FOR COUNTLESS YOUNG VICTORIA LACROSSE PLAYERS, BECOMING A VICTORIA SR SHAMROCK IS A LIFE LONG DREAM THAT IS AN GOAL OF YEARS OF HARD WORK.

Being able to pull on the clover and play this great game in front of family and friends is an incredible feeling that few get to experience but many strive for. Our team has an abundant amount of experience. determination, and pride. Which, are all key components to creating a championship team."

That chemistry and bond has been a key focal point for the Shamrocks over the past few years as GM Chris Welch has been trying to build a championship calibre team made up of local and import players. "The moves that our general manager has made in the offseason have just bolstered every position on the floor. I don't believe we have a weak spot on our team."

Confidence has never been a weak spot for King either. Flash back to the 2013 Mann Cup when playing as a Jr A call-up in his first ever Mann Cup game, he scored a natural hat-trick in the third period including a high-light real behind the back game winner that gave everyone a little taste of the talent the Victoria product has. "Those were definitely the biggest goals I have



scored in my life, says King who wears number 19 in honour of Victoria lacrosse icon Paul Gait. Strangely enough it's not because of this author. "I will never forget what coach Bob Hayes said before the game to me. He said "You only got two games, so make them count." And that was just racing through my mind the whole weekend"

His ability to step up on the big stage is a quality the Shamrocks brass are keen on as this team moves forward with King being an integral part of the future. The future is now for King but he's always remember where the dream started. "Ever since I was a kid watching the Shamrocks play in the old memorial arena, I knew that one day I wanted to play for them. Wearing the jersey that so many legends have worn in the past

is an absolute honour for me. The amount of pride is unfathomable. Every time I have the opportunity to put the green and white on I am extremely grateful."

Pride. Tradition. Family. Three power words that tie local players to this organization that makes playing for their hometown team all that more special "Being away at school my friends and family don't get much of an opportunity to watch me play which is unfortunate, but at the same time it makes it extremely special to play in front of them when I am home. I am so thankful that I am able to play in such an amazing place that just so happens to be my home."

In the end, we are all thankful that the King has Returned and he's here to stay for quite some time.
