Chair Report:

- Congratulations to Richmond as hosts of the Youth Provincials. Women's Provincials Host announcement to come.
- We are still looking for a U11 Provincial Tournament Host for Youth on Feb 9-11. Dave Goulet has reached out to a few clubs.
- BCLA is working to find budget for Women's U11 Provincials as the policy was passed after budgeting.
- Standings for tiering, I will defer discussion on this item, but we believe we have clean process for moving teams at tiering this season. I will send details around to all club reps.
- Thanks for the open communication on the Whatsapp Group Chats, has proven beneficial so far.
- Tier 1 Committee has reviewed and assigned about 15 players, some of those TBD depending on a remaining tryout in New West tonight. I don't think we received as many applications as we thought but

overall the process seems to be moving along. Thanks to all the Committee members, Robb Alexander and Karen Cameron especially.

- We are anticipating reaching almost 200 releases by the time the end of September comes.
- Our overall self-reported numbers are up year over year. We will issue our final numbers once registrations are confirmed by the BCLA in November.
- Want to say briefly that we know that our communication on the Women's U19 was not the best and we
 will be addressing that in the coming week. It was not our intention to suggest that the women weren't
 able to participate in some manner with the PCFLL. However, the decision to not age down the girls was
 made with in the spirit of having the U17 girls fully participate with their own age group and that is very
 difficult if there are also 17 and 18 year olds vying for playing time.
- We will send out some communication on this and we'll discuss with the women's reps at a final declaration meeting within the next two weeks.
- We have emailed the BCLA to determine the sanction status of the Rivals Lacrosse League that is holding
 games on Sunday and Monday evenings. This is direct competition to the PCFLL it is important for
 participants, officials, and coaches to understand their risk level with regards to the BCLA and Lacrosse
 Canada events such as playing for Team BC at Nationals. I'm still waiting on a reply from the BCLA office.

Declarations:

- Women's declared numbers are reviewed (see attached)
 - Adanacs aging up U7 players to U9
 - Three clubs who have U9 women's teams will communicate with each to try to combine into one location to play weekly
 - Adanacs aging up U11 players to U13
 - U11 may end up having soft tiers (blue, red, white)
 - Delta may have U13 releases
 - League will review U13 after 3-4 games
 - U15 will be two groups of 4 teams
 - Poco advises that they do not currently have a goalie, concerned about declaring T1
 - The BCLA handbook is incorrect coming out of Special Session. There is no oversized team for women's. You can dress only 18 players per game, including goalies. Caution: Provincials/tournaments are allowed to have team size limits. Directives will be updated end of September, early October.
 - Adanacs would like to consider tiering at U17 even with only 6 teams. Will review at the women's final declaration meeting and Brad/Stacy will look at before that meeting.
 - Some Burnaby players are not wanting to merge with Poco so the number of releases will likely drop a bit.
 - o Big Al tournament is Sept 23
- Youth declared numbers are reviewed (see attached)
 - Surrey is declaring a U7 team
 - U7 will try to play regionally, depending on field time
 - o U9 commissioner has a good handle on the division and will work on the matchups
 - U13 Tier 2 will be split into colour divisions (red & silver) after tiering as we don't have a good gauge on team strength at this time
 - U13 Tier 2 playoffs will follow their colours
 - May use the U11 standings from 2023 to determine colour placement to start. Brad, Cal and Mike will discuss
 - U15 Tier 2 will be split into colour divisions (red & silver). Will look at standings from 2023 to determine placement
 - U19 Surrey is going to be releasing to Delta
