1st Chair:

- Roger is in attendance by phone so unable to chair the meeting. Kelly to chair
- Cohort list attached
- U18
 - All North Shore releases are in
 - All Valley releases are in
 - Both New West and Poco got goalies
 - Motion to approve U18 oversized rosters for Chilliwack, Coquitlam, Langley, New West & Ridge Meadows
 - Motioned by: Angie Wolfe
 - Seconded by: Bill Tyler
 - Motion passed by majority vote
- U15
 - Langley has 29 players but will be releasing 9 players
 - New West has 24 players but will be releasing 2 players, 2 do not want to be released
 - North Shore registrations include 3 players from Sechelt. Do they need releases?
 - No release needed, Sechelt is free agents

- Motion to approve Delta oversized roster
 - 13 multi-sport athletes
 - Couple of players who signed up just to play with friends
 - If approved, can only have 20 players attend games
 - Motioned by: Alex Vanichuk
 - Seconded by: Shaun Ashworth
 - Motion passed by majority vote
- Motion to approve Richmond/Vancouver oversized roster
 - Only one goalie
 - Motioned by: Kelly Scott
 - Seconded by: Angie Wolfe
 - Motion passed by majority vote
- Will wait on releases from Langley and New West
- Burnaby, Ridge, Valley and Surrey need those releases
- U13
 - Langley and Poco would like to merge their Tier 3 players to create one team. Poco would release 7 players to Langley
 - North Shore may have two releases but the players have not yet responding
 - North Shore releases will go to Rich/Van if they come through
 - New West requests to be moved from Cohort 3 to 4 just for travel purposes. Approved
 - Motion to approve Chilliwack having two balanced Tier 2 teams
 - Motioned: Kelly Scott
 - Seconded: Angie Wolfe
 - Motion passed by majority vote
 - Coquitlam offers to have two balanced Tier 2 teams as well if needed for cohort purposes
 - Kelly to review cohorts again
- U11
 - North Shore would really like releases
 - Richmond/Vancouver unable to field a second team so they will just have 1 in Tier 2
 - Motion to approve oversized rosters for Burnaby and New West
 - Motioned: Kelly Scott
 - Seconded: Angie Wolfe
 - Motion passed by majority vote
 - Valley may have up to 4 releases. 1 may play girls. Releases would go to Mission
- U9
 - Langley has submitted a proposal to include goalies on U7/U9 teams
 - The letter will be sent to Angie to send a copy to all clubs
 - Each club must push BCLA to get this changed
 - We cannot have two games going at the same time as we would be over the 50 allowed
 - North Shore has two U7 players that could come to U9
 - Going to revisit the roster sizes with BCLA as part of the proposal due to large number of “oversized” rosters
- U7
 - Burnaby unsure if they will be able to field a team due to the no cross cohort rules. Have girls playing on both U7 and U8 teams. Waiting on ruling

- U5
 - More clubs running U5 in house
 - Only Chilliwack and Mission have enough players to properly field teams. They will talk offline and try to work out grouping together
- Head Referee
 - Jody requests a copy of the number of teams so they can figure out how many refs they need
 - Tough for new ref allocators who do not have the previous lists
 - Clinics are filling up fast. Please get our refs registered asap
 - To be clear, play will be fully contact
 - Loose ball rule will be very difficult, and everyone must have patience and show respect
- Discussion
 - Start date was set for October 10-11 but will have problems fielding refs as Evolve has a tournament in Kamloops
 - Motion to change season start date from October 10-11 to October 17-18
 - Motioned by: Kelly Scott
 - Seconded by: Margot Gallant
 - Chilliwack motions to amend the season date to allow U7-U11 to start on Oct 10-11 and U13 and up to start Oct 17-18 to allow the younger players to get games in prior to bad weather
 - Motioned by: Tyler Crompton
 - Seconded by: Greg Leong
 - Motioned passed by majority
 - Amendment to last minutes. It says stop time in the second half and should be running time
 - Jody suggests that Roger revisit the topic with Jeff. Stop time is important and will not lengthen the games
 - There are no Season A and Season B anymore. Giving players the ability to decline Season B could cause problems with number of teams if players back out
 - Electronic whistles, will they be allowed
 - Jody is still working on it but thinks they may be allowed
 - Whistles that PCFLL ordered are on back order and should arrive Oct 1
 - Langley is no longer playing at Willoughby Fields, they are based out of Yorkson
 - Poco is now allowing alcohol at Gates Field
 - BCLA has a no alcohol policy for minor sport
