- U19 Hosted in Burnaby
 - No Tiers 3 Teams (PCFLL)
 - Adanacs do not have enough players that can make provincials, Surrey did not declare leaving only Burnaby and Mission

- Provincial Volunteers:

 - Pragmatic to try to fill volunteer spots prior to knowing the game schedule.
 Parents will want volunteer when their child plays
 - Clubs should line up volunteers and exact times will be filled closer to date
- o TeamBC and League requirements
 - The FD will be revising the current policy for commitment to the League
 - Should be more monitoring of the 50% rule
 - Many of the issues with U19 not showing up is not just the TeamBC players. Seems to be lack of interest overall
 - The few girls that are showing for Surrey are the TeamBC girls
 - Injuries an issue




About Us
