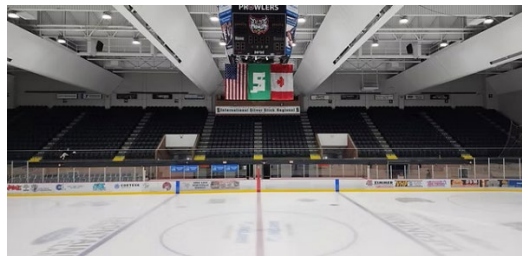


My Trip to See the Port Huron Prowlers

We will go inside the big building. There will be other people there, lots of fans who love hockey just like me. People might cheer and get excited. This means the game is fun!



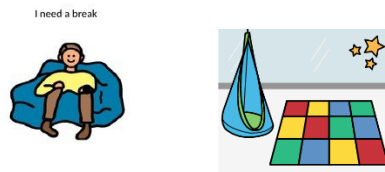
It might be a little loud inside the rink. The music might play, and people will clap and yell "Go Prowlers!" The sounds might be big, but that's part of the excitement of a live game.
