SOCKERS REPORT // Sockers And Comets To Meet Twice This Weekend And Toth Earns San Diego's Second Shutout Of The Season



The San Diego Sockers—presented by Kaiser Permanente—fell into a first-place tie with Baltimore after the Blast edged the homestanding Sockers 5-4 on Sunday. The teams are tied at 36 points, with San Diego having a game in hand. Nick Perera continues to top the scoring list with 30 points (16G, 14A). Chris Toth made his second consecutive start since his return from a broken hand. He secured the squad's second shutout of the season by making 14 saves in a 4-0 win over Empire last Thursday. The new Sockers W team will play matches against the Empire Strykers women's team, with the first being played at Frontwave Arena on March 22, 1:45pm.

MASL NOTES



In what could be considered the most competitive season in MASL history, a new team is in or tied for first place. San Diego and Baltimore are tops with 36 points each, followed by Milwaukee (35), St. Louis (34), Kansas City (31). Empire (25) and Tacoma (23) are battling for the sixth and final playoff spot. Milwaukee's Alex Sanchez leads the league in scoring with 42 points and 27 goals. Teammate Mario Alvarez and Baltimore's Oumar Sylla have 18 assist a piece. Ambush GK Paulo Nascimento has an MASL best 4.55 GAA, while San Diego's Boris Pardo has MASL-best .732 save %. The MASL Monday show features Milwaukee Wave netminder William Banahene.
