SOCKERS REPORT // Sockers Win On Alumni Night Featuring The Annual Alumni Halftime Game, Crow HOF Ceremony & Chiles Bobblehead Giveaway

The San Diego Sockers—presented by Kaiser Permanente—welcomed home over 40 former players for the annual Alumni Night and halftime game on February 7. Kevin Crow was also honored in a short ceremony for his upcoming 2026 National Soccer Hall of Fame enshrinement. The current Sockers impressed the alumni with an 11-4 win over Utica City on Kraig Chiles bobblehead giveaway night. San Diego sits in third place with 24 points (13 games), three points behind both Milwaukee (14 games) and Kansas City (16 games).


MASL NOTES
