**ICE BREAKERS PRE-SCOUT:** Mentor is currently riding a season-long nine-game losing streak that dates back to January 24. The Ice Breakers last picked up a point in a 4-3 shootout loss against Carolina on January 26. With 45 points and a record of 14-23-0-3, Mentor is in fourth place in the Eastern Division and eighth in the FPHL. The Ice Breakers are led in scoring by **F Declan Conway** (29-23-52), **F Alex Morrow** (7-16-23) and **F Nate Farrington** (6-17-23).

**ENFORCERS PRE-SCOUT:** Elmira has won each of its last two games and eight of nine overall. Last weekend, the Enforcers took two of three in a weekend series against Watertown. Elmira is in second place in the Eastern Division and fourth in the 10-team FPHL. The Enforcers' top scorers are **F Tyler Gjurich** (35-36-71), **F Ahmed Mahfouz** (23-48-71) and **F Hudson Michealis** (22-46-48).

**SEASON SERIES:** Today's game marks the first of six matchups in the season series between the Ice Breakers and Enforcers, including the first of two at Mentor Ice Arena. Elmira posted a 6-2-2-0 record against Mentor last year, but the two clubs split their final four games of the regular season.

**NEXT HOME GAME: Sat, Feb. 22nd vs. Elmira Enforcers, 6:30 p.m. EST**  
The Ice Breakers continue a four-game homestand with a jam-packed night of promotions on Cancer Awareness Night. **ROAD TRIP REVIEW:** The Ice Breakers’ recent six-game road trip didn’t go as planned, to say the least. Mentor dropped all six matchups on the three-week, two-city trip, including four losses in Port Huron. Following a pair of duds against the Prowlers, the Ice Breakers were outscored 16-2 over the first four periods of their two-game set against Columbus. From there, the team was able to settle down and edged out the River Dragons 7-3 over the remainder of the contest.

Following another setback last Friday against Port Huron, the Ice Breakers played one of their better games in recent weeks in a 4-3 loss to close out the road trip. **D Jiri Pestuka** was credited with a goal and an assist while **D Dominick Horvath** found the back of the net for the first time in his FPHL career.

**A LOOK AHEAD:** At this point, the remainder of the season will be focused on steady improvement while aiming to lock down a spot in the Commissioner’s Cup playoffs. Mentor is still in firm control of the fourth seed in the East Division, 21 points ahead of Delaware. The Ice Breakers and Thunder will battle in four consecutive games from March 8-15 in a pivotal series that could play a significant role in determining the playoff picture.

**KEYS TO SUCCESS:** Grabbing an early lead has done wonders for the confidence of this Ice Breakers squad. When Mentor nets the opening goal of the contest, it has posted a solid 12-6-0-0 record. The club has struggled immensely when the opposition strikes first, putting up a paltry 2-17-0-3 mark. It is also worth mentioning that Mentor has gone 11-3-0-1 when it has the lead at the first intermission but has yet to win in 13 tries when trailing after one period.

**VETERAN PRESENCE:** The signing of **F Josh Newberg** is already paying dividends for the Ice Breakers. At the age of 32, Newberg is the oldest member of Mentor’s roster. He appeared in his 100th career FPHL game last Saturday and already has a goal and an assist over four outings as an Ice Breaker. Newberg, who broke into the league in 2017, provides a much-needed veteran voice in the locker room and has a 15-28-43 scoring line in his career. He had a 12-game stint with the ECHL’s Elmira Jackals in 2016, scoring at a point-per-game pace with four goals and eight assists.

**SETTING RECORDS:** With his goal in the third period against Columbus on February 8, **F Declan Conway** set a new franchise record for points in a single season (52). He has 72 career points in Mentor and needs only one more to take over as the Ice Breakers’ all-time leading scorer.

**STILL PRODUCING:** Over the last month or so, **F Steven Fowler** has been Mentor’s most dangerous forward. When healthy, the 22-year-old is a point-per-game scorer in the FPHL and has posted an 8-12-20 line in 21 appearances. Since the calendar flipped to 2020, Fowler has registered at least a point in 10 of his 12 games, including three multi-point performances.

**IRON MAN:** With several players missing games for the first time this season on the Ice Breakers’ recent road trip, **F Alex Morrow** has become the team’s leader in games played, appearing in all 40 contests to date. In his career, Morrow has suited up for 90 games as an Ice Breaker, trailing only **F Nate Farrington** for the team record.

**MAGIC NUMBER:** Throughout the season, the Ice Breakers have seen tremendous success when scoring four goals or more, winning 13 of 14 games. Unfortunately, Mentor has hit that number only twice since the beginning of January. Both games were victories.

**WELCOME BACK:** Tonight’s game marks the return of **F Mark Essery** to Northeast Ohio. The Framingham, Massachusetts native was traded to Elmira on February 6 in exchange for Horvath and **F Jack Chudleigh**, who has not reported to Mentor. Essery, who was the Ice Breakers’ leading scorer a season ago with 51 points, has dished out three assists and earned a plus-four rating over six outings as an Enforcer.
