ICE BREAKERS PRE-SCOUT: The Ice Breakers were swept at home by Port Huron from December 27-28 before being shutout against Danville on New Year's Eve 3-0. With 39 points and a record of 13-12-0-0, Mentor is in third place in the Eastern Division and sixth in the FPHL. Mentor is led in scoring by **F Declan Conway** (24-19-43), **F Jon Buttitta** (18-20-38), and **D Brody Duncan** (5-14-19).

DASHERS PRE-SCOUT: The Dashers took two of three games from Columbus in a road series before posting a 3-0 win over Mentor on New Year's Eve at home and falling to the Ice Breakers 4-2 last night. Danville is in third place in the Western Division and fifth in the 10-team FPHL. The Dashers' top scorers are **F Fred Hein** (17-15-32), **F AJ Tesoriero** (8-9-17), and **F Jesse Neher** (7-10-17).

SEASON SERIES: Tonight marks the sixth of eight matchups between the Ice Breakers and Dashers and the second of four contests at Mentor Ice Arena. Danville leads the season series with a 3-2-0-0 following a 4-2 Ice Breakers road win last night. The Ice Breakers posted a 4-4-1-2 record against Danville last year in the 11-game season series between the two clubs.

WEEK IN REVIEW: Last weekend, the Ice Breakers ran into a hot goaltender a suffered back-to-back home losses against **G Chris Paulin** and the streaking Port Huron Prowlers, who are now up to nine wins in a row. The series opener saw Paulin stop all 42 Ice Breakers shot en route to a 2-0 win thanks to goals by **D Joe Pace Jr.** and **F Matt Graham**. Port Huron completed the sweep the following evening with a 4 -2 win that was powered by three unanswered goals.

On New Year’s Eve, the Ice Breakers were shut out for the second time this season in a 3-0 loss to the Danville Dashers. **G Harley White** made 23 saves for the Dashers. Last night saw Mentor get its revenge in a 4-2 win. **F Declan Conway** scored twice while **F Nate Farrington** added three points, including a clutch go-ahead goal in the final five minutes of regulation. **G Austyn Roudebush** stopped 35 of 37 shots to move to 11-10-0-0.

SNAPPING OUT OF IT: For most players, three games without registering a point wouldn’t be notable. But when **F Declan Conway** was held off the scoresheet for three consecutive contests, it marked his longest scoreless streak since a five-game stretch last February. Conway broke out of the minor slump with two goals last night in the Ice Breakers’ 4-2 win, retaking the FPHL lead in goals scored (24).

LOOKING FOR ANSWERS: While the Ice Breakers have plenty of talent among their current group of forwards on paper, the position group has not produced on the ice. Only three forwards have recorded double-digit points: Conway (24-19-43), **F Alex Morrow** (5-10-15), and **F Nate Farrington** (6-10-16). Three of Mentor’s top seven scorers are defensemen.

BOTH ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM: Mentor continues to excel on the penalty kill with an 86.2 percent efficiency on the year, good for second best in the FPHL. Conversely, the power play unit has regressed and is now scoring on only 16.2 percent of its opportunities, which is eighth in the league. The Ice Breakers haven’t been perfect on the kill, but they play a disciplined style that relies heavily on Roudebush. The success of the penalty kill unit has been one of the highlights of the team in a year that has seen seven of the 10 FPHL clubs convert on at least 20 percent of their power plays so far.

STILL UNDER SUSPENSION: **F Mark Essery** is one game into his three-game suspension received as the result of a major penalty for elbowing on the road against Danville on New Year’s Eve. Essery will be eligible to return next Saturday night as the Ice Breakers battle the Carolina Thunderbirds on the road.

DECIDING THINGS EARLY: Despite coming close on several occasions, the Ice Breakers have still not played an overtime period. They’re one of three teams that have yet to see an extra period. Last season, Mentor did not play in overtime until January 4 in a 5-4 road loss to the Elmira Enforcers.

IN NEED OF A HOT START: When the Ice Breakers hold a lead at the first intermission, they’ve won 10 of 11 games. The club has yet to win in six tries when it’s behind at the first break. One of the keys to tonight’s game for both sides will be grabbing an early lead.

LOW-SCORING BATTLE: Both the Dashers and Ice Breakers ranked among the top three defensive clubs in the FPHL, largely thanks to strong goaltending. Mentor is allowing exactly three goals per night while Danville is close behind (3.1 GA/G).
