ICE BREAKERS PRE-SCOUT: Mentor was swept by Danville in a two-game set on January 17-18 before snapping a five-game skid with a 4-2 win over Battle Creek. Mentor enters today's game having lost two straight against Carolina. With 44 points and a record of 14-17-0-2, Mentor is in fourth place in the Eastern Division and eighth in the FPHL. Mentor is led in scoring by **F Declan Conway** (26-21-47), **F Jon Buttitta** (18-20-38), and **D Brody Duncan** (7-14-21).

THUNDERBIRDS PRE-SCOUT: Carolina has won six straight contests, including a two-game sweep over Delaware and four victories against the Ice Breakers. The Thunderbirds are in first place in the Western Division and lead the 10-team FPHL. Carolina's top scorers are **F Petr Panacek** (16-31-47), **F Jan Salak** (18-21-39), and **F Michael Bunn** (13-24-37).

SEASON SERIES: Today's game marks the seventh and final contest in the season series between these two clubs, including the third at Mentor Ice Arena. Carolina has won all six matchups to this point, posting a 5-0-1-0 record. The Ice Breakers have not beaten the Thunderbirds since November of 2018, dropping 16 straight contests against the defending Commissioner's Cup champions.

WEEK IN REVIEW: Last Friday, the Ice Breakers allowed three unanswered goals in a 4-2 loss against the Danville Dashers. In his first start since **G Austyn Roudebush** was loaned to the Roanoke Rail Yard Dawgs (SPHL), **G Jordan Brant** put together a solid outing, stopping 27 of 30 shots. Mentor fell by the same score on Saturday night despite a 46-save effort by Brant. The two clubs were knotted at 2-2 midway through the third period before Danville struck twice over a span of under three minutes. On Monday, the Ice Breakers played host to the Battle Creek Rumble Bees and salvaged the homestand with a much-needed 4-2 victory. With the game tied at 1-1 in the third period, **F Mark Essery** scored the next three Ice Breaker goals, including an empty-netter with under a second to go that sealed the win and capped off his first hat trick of the season.

This weekend's series against Carolina hasn't gone Mentor's way as the Thunderbirds logged back-to-back wins at the Winston-Salem Fairgrounds Annex on Friday and Saturday by scores of 4-1 and 7-2.

IT'S BEEN AWHILE: Only seven members of the Ice Breakers current roster were on the club the last time Mentor topped Carolina, a 3-0 shutout win on November 24, 2018. Since then, the Thunderbirds have logged 16 straight wins over the Ice Breakers. It's been an incredible stretch of dominance, but Mentor will be looking to halt the lengthy streak this afternoon.

THE NEW GUY: **G Frankie McClendon** didn't have to travel to make his Ice Breakers debut as the former Carolina Thunderbird played in both games in Winston-Salem. McClendon stopped 35 of 37 shots after coming on in relief on Friday before making 34 saves the following evening in the 7-2 Mentor loss.

CAN'T GET IT DONE: The Ice Breakers' power play unit has seen its efficiency experience a freefall over the last month. It currently sits at a season-low 12.7 percent following an 0 for 18 performance over the last two games. In order to beat a quality team like Carolina, the power play woes must be solved. Mentor has struggled to a 4-13-0-1 record when failing to score on the man advantage.

BACK TOGETHER: With the trade that saw the Ice Breakers acquire McClendon while shipping **F Chad Herron** to the Thunderbirds, **D Jiri Pestuka** has been reunited with his former teammate. The two won championship rings as Thunderbirds last season.

THE MIDDLE FRAME: The second period has been Mentor's worst period of the season and the only period in which it has been outscored (40-35). On Friday and Saturday combined, the Ice Breakers were edged by a 3-1 margin, continuing what's been a season-long trend.

BACK TO HIS FORMER SELF: Despite some injury issues this season that have limited him to 16 games, **F Steven Fowler** is Mentor's sixth-leading scorer. He scored and logged an assist last night and has been the only Ice Breaker to consistently produce against the Thunderbirds this season, scoring at a point-per-game pace (1-3-4, 4 GP). Fowler, **F Tim Perks**, and **F Declan Conway** made up Mentor's top line last night, and the trio was on the ice for both Ice Breaker goals.

ALUMNI UPDATE: **G Austyn Roudebush** has played in three games for the Roanoke Rail Yard Dawgs, putting together a 2.65 goals-against average and a .918 save percentage. Meanwhile, **F Jon Buttitta** has a pair of goals and 3 assists for five points in nine games for the Quad City Storm.
