ICE BREAKERS PRE-SCOUT: The Ice Breakers split a two-game series against the Delaware Thunder last weekend before defeating the Danville Dashers 7-4 on Sunday. They fell to the Prowlers, 4-2, last night at Mentor Ice Arena. With 21 points and a record of 7-3-0-0, Mentor is in second place in the Eastern Division and third in the FPHL. Mentor is led in scoring by **F Jon Buttitta** (12-11-23), **F Parker Moskal** (6-14-20), and **F Declan Conway** (6-8-14).

PROWLERS PRE-SCOUT: Port Huron just wrapped up a stretch of four straight home games against the Columbus River Dragons that saw both clubs claim a pair of victories before defeating Mentor last night. The Prowlers are in third place in the Western Division and in sixth place in the league. Port Huron's top scorers are **F Matt Robertson** (9-9-18), **F Matt Graham** (5-9-14), and **F Dalton Jay** (4-6-10).

SEASON SERIES: Tonight marks the second of 10 matchups between the Ice Breakers and Prowlers and the second of six contests at Mentor Ice Arena following last night's 4-2 Prowlers win. Mentor posted a 6-7-0-0 record against Port Huron last year in the 13-game season series between the two clubs and scored double-digit goals against the Prowlers on two separate occasions.

WEEK IN REVIEW: Last Friday, a three-point effort by **F Jon Buttitta** powered the Ice Breakers to a 5-2 win over Delaware, stretching the team's victory streak to five games and extending the Thunder's winless skid to five in a row. **F Nate Farrington** found the back of the net for the first time this season, scoring just 26 seconds into the contest.

The following evening home, the Ice Breakers racked up a season-high 53 shots but couldn't solve Thunder netminder **G Aaron Taylor** as the visitors claimed a 3-2 win, snapping Mentor's win streak at five games. The Ice Breakers scored a power play goal for the third consecutive game in the loss.

To finish out the weekend on Sunday afternoon, Mentor played host Danville and downed the visitors by a score of 7-4. Buttitta logged his third four-point game of the season with a pair of goals and two helpers while **F Mark Essery** dished out three assists.

Last night, a three-goal second period propelled Port Huron to a 4-2 victory over Mentor in Northeast Ohio. **F Declan Conway** and **F Alex Morrow** (SH) both scored in the third period, but Mentor's slow start and poor second frame proved to be too much to overcome.

ALWAYS A BATTLE: Mentor and Port Huron played a fantastic 13-game season series last year with the Prowlers holding a slight 7-6-0-0 edge over the Ice Breakers. However, Mentor played some its best games of the season against the Prowlers, including its first victory in franchise history, a 6-4 win on the road on November 17, 2018. Other notable affairs included a 4-3 Ice Breakers home win on New Year's Eve and a pair of wins that saw Mentor register 10 goals or more.

SHARING THE PUCK: Unlike last season, Mentor has brought a balanced offensive attack among its forwards. Six different players are scoring at a point-per-game pace, including Conway (6-8-14), Morrow (2-7-9), and Essery (2-6-8). Twelve different players have scored multiple goals for the Ice Breakers.

LEADING THE PACK: Buttitta (12-11-23) and **F Parker Moskal** (6-14-20) represent the top two scorers in the FPHL to this point. Both players were late-season additions last year and have picked up right where they left off. Buttitta has collected four or more points on three separate occasions while Moskal has registered multiple points in six of his nine appearances, including a six-assist performance in the Ice Breakers' home opener on November 9, a 10-3 win over Battle Creek.

OUT-SHINING THE STARS: Port Huron's high-scoring trio of **F Matt Robertson** (9-9-18), **F Matt Graham** (5-9-14), and **F Dalton Jay** (4-6-10) were all kept off the scoresheet last night while **F Austin Fetterly** and **D Bryan Parsons** combined for five assists and **F Justin Portillo** netted a pair of goals.

ROBERTSON RISING: After a relatively quiet stretch compared to his normally lofty standards, Port Huron's Robertson erupted for five goals and five assists a stretch of three games, including a dominant performance last Saturday that saw him factor into all six of his team's goals with a hat trick and three assists.

Robertson, the FPHL's fifth all-time leading scorer with 299 points (126-173-299), could hit the 300-point milestone for his career tonight barring a shutdown defensive performance by the Ice Breakers.

FRANCHISE LEADERS: Three current Prowlers rank within the top five on the club's all-time scoring list: Robertson (first, 299 points), **F Dalton Jay** (third, 173 points), and **F Matt Graham** (fifth, 156 points).
