ICE BREAKERS PRE-SCOUT: The Ice Breakers claimed four of six possible points in a two-game set against Danville from January 3-4 before dropping consecutive games on the road against Carolina, including a 3-2 shootout loss. Last night, Mentor jumped out to a 2-1 lead against the Dashers before falling 4-2. With 41 points and a record of 13-14-0-2, Mentor is in fourth place in the Eastern Division and seventh in the FPHL. Mentor is led in scoring by **F Declan Conway** (26-19-45), **F Jon Buttitta** (18-20-38), and **D Brody Duncan** (6-14-20).

DASHERS PRE-SCOUT: The Dashers have won four straight games since a 4-2 defeat at home against Mentor on January 3, including a two-game sweep of Battle Creek last weekend and last night's 4-2 win over the Ice Breakers. Danville is in third place in the Western Division and fourth in the 10-team FPHL. The Dashers' top scorers are **F Fred Hein** (19-16-35), **F Jesse Neher** (8-15-23), and **F AJ Tesoriero** (10-10-20).

SEASON SERIES: Tonight marks the eighth and final matchup between the Ice Breakers and Dashers and the fourth contest at Mentor Ice Arena. Danville leads the season series with a 4-2-1-0 record following last night's 4-2 win. The Ice Breakers posted a 4-4-1-2 record against Danville last year in the 11-game season series between the two

WEEK IN REVIEW: Last weekend, the Ice Breakers ran into a hot goaltender a suffered back-to-back home losses against **G Chris Paulin** and the streaking Port Huron Prowlers, who are now up to nine wins in a row. The series opener saw Paulin stop all 42 Ice Breakers shot en route to a 2-0 win thanks to goals by **D Joe Pace Jr.** and **F Matt Graham**. Port Huron completed the sweep the following evening with a 4 -2 win that was powered by three unanswered goals. On New Year’s Eve, the Ice Breakers were shut out for the second time this season in a 3-0 loss to the Danville Dashers. **G Harley White** made 23 saves for the Dashers. Last night saw Mentor get its revenge in a 4-2 win. **F Declan Conway** scored twice while **F Nate Farrington** added three points, including a clutch go-ahead goal in the final five minutes of regulation. **G Austyn Roudebush** stopped 35 of 37 shots to move to 11-10-0-0.

PROMOTED: The last time these two clubs matched up in early January, Roudebush and **G Jesse Gordichuk** battled all the way to a shootout with Gordichuk’s Dashers claiming a 2-1 victory. On Thursday, both goaltenders were loaned to SPHL clubs as Gordichuk joined the Birmingham Bulls and Roudebush headed to Roanoke, Virginia to sign with the Rail Yard Dawgs.

OUR HOUSE: The Ice Breakers will be looking to improve upon their poor 5-7-0-1 record at Mentor Ice Arena. Head Coach Iain Duncan spoke about the need to defend home ice earlier this season, but the team has not consistently done so to this point.

FORCED INTO ACTION: **G Jordan Brant** has spent most of the season on the bench, but he’s now the Ice Breakers go-to option between the pipes. Brant gave his chance a team to win last night, stopping 27 of 30 shots and providing solid goaltending. On the campaign, the Alberta native has a 2.99 goals-against average and .902 save percentage.

KEYS TO VICTORY: Outshooting the opponent has been crucial to Mentor’s success this season. When the Ice Breakers are outshot, they’ve gone 2-10-0-2. Conversely, the club has won 11 of 16 games when tying in shots or accumulating more attempts at the net than the opponent.

Another important factor in Mentor’s ability to win is the performance of the power play unit. When scoring on the man advantage, the Ice Breakers have a 10-4-0-1 record. They’ve dropped 11 of the 14 games in which they’ve failed to score a power-play tally.

COLD SPELL: **F Declan Conway** was at one point the FPHL leader in both goals and points. Over his last eight games, Conway has only four points, all goals. Two of those tallies came in one contest during that span. With so many Ice Breakers struggling offensively, the club needs its top scorer to regain his scoring touch from earlier in the year.

A LOOK AHEAD: Things don’t get much easier for Mentor next weekend as it is tasked with a three-in-three matchup against the Carolina Thunderbirds. The Ice Breakers have not topped the Thunderbirds since November 2018.

JOINING THE CLUB: With his goal last night, **D Brody Duncan** became the fourth Ice Breaker to score 20 points this season and the second on the active roster. Duncan is fifth in scoring among FPHL defensemen with a 6-14-20 line.
