ICE BREAKERS PRE-SCOUT: The Ice Breakers logged a two-game sweep in a home-and-home series against Battle Creek before falling to Carolina on back-to-back nights at Mentor Ice Arena. Thursday night, the Ice Breakers snapped Danbury's winning streak with a 6-5 triumph before falling 2-0 yesterday at home against the Prowlers. With 36 points and a record of 12-10-0-0, Mentor is in third place in the Eastern Division and fifth in the FPHL. Mentor is led in scoring by **F Declan Conway** (22-19-41), **F Jon Buttitta** (18-20-38), and **D Brody Duncan** (5-12-17).

PROWLERS PRE-SCOUT: The Prowlers are riding high with a seven-game winning streak. Port Huron is coming off a pair of impressive road wins over the Danville Dashers the weekend before Christmas and shutout the Ice Breakers last night. The Prowlers are in second place in the Western Division and third in the 10-team FPHL. Port Huron's top scorers are **F Matt Robertson** (15-22-37), **F Matt Graham** (9-18-27), and **F Dalton Jay** (7-9-16).

SEASON SERIES: Tonight marks the fourth of 10 matchups between the Ice Breakers and Prowlers and the fourth of six contests at Mentor Ice Arena. Mentor split a two-game set against Port Huron at home from November 22-23. The Ice Breakers posted a 6-7-0-0 record against Port Huron last year in the 13-game season series between the two clubs.

NEXT HOME GAME: Sat., Jan. 4th vs. Danville Dashers, 6:30 p.m. EST

The Ice Breakers play their first home game of 2020 with a special ticket promotion for all fans. In honor of Mentor's "440" area code, four general admission tickets will be available for just \$40. Doors will open at 5:30 p.m. as the Ice Breakers wrap up a stretch of three straight games against the Dashers.

WEEK IN REVIEW: Last at home, the Ice Breakers were defeated by the Carolina Thunderbirds, 5-1. Mentor scored first at 6:36 of the second frame when **D Brody Duncan** found twine, breaking open what had been a tightly contested matchup. The Thunderbirds answered with a pair of goals over a span of less than a minute before striking three times in the final period to take home the series-opening win.

Saturday's game saw the return of **G Austyn Roudebush**, who stopped 29 of 31 shots but fell to 9-7-0-0 after the Ice Breakers suffered a 2-1 loss. Carolina scored at 15:40 of the first period before going up 2-0 late in the second period on a goal by **F Daniel Martin**. **F Declan Conway** scored the lone Mentor tally at 4:24 of the final frame on a feed from linemate **F Jon Buttitta**.

THIRSTY THURSDAY: The Ice Breakers jumped out to a 3-0 lead in the first five minutes of Thursday night's win over Danbury, but the Hat Tricks fought back to within a goal at 3-2 at the first intermission. **F Nate Farrington** scored 52 seconds into the second frame before both clubs traded goals the rest of the way with Conway and **F Mark Essery** finding twine for the Ice Breakers, making it a 6-5 final.

LAST NIGHT: For the first time in franchise history, the Ice Breakers were shut out on home ice yesterday in a 2-0 defeat at the hands of the Prowlers and **G Chris Paulin**, who stopped all 37 shots he faced en route to his second shutout. **G Austyn Roudebush** had a fantastic night, stopped 43 of 45 shots, but the Ice Breakers weren't able to provide him with any offensive help.

PROMOTED: **F Jon Buttitta** became the first Ice Breaker this season to receive an SPHL call-up yesterday when he was loaned to the Quad City Storm. Buttitta has 38 points (18-20-38) over 20 games with Mentor and was named the FPHL's Rookie of the Month for November. He joins a Storm team that features several FPHL alumni, including **F Stephen Gaul** (Danville Dashers), **G Ryan Mulder** (Elmira Enforcers), and **F Dean Yakura** (Danbury Titans). Last night in his SPHL debut, Buttitta recorded the primary assist on Quad City's lone goal in a 3-1 loss to the Evansville Thunderbolts.

STILL RECOVERING: Mentor's prized trade acquisition, **D Jiri Pestuka**, was unavailable for last weekend's series against Carolina. The Czech Republic native is not expected to play in this weekend's contests. His presence will certainly boost the Ice Breakers upon his return. **F Chad Herron**, who was added along with Pestuka in a swap with the Columbus River Dragons is also nursing an injury and has yet to suit up for the Ice Breakers.

SHUTTING THEM DOWN: Currently operating at an 87.0 percent clip, the Ice Breakers' penalty kill is second-best in the FPHL, trailing only Carolina (90.5 percent). Mentor is tied with Columbus with seven shorthanded goals on the year, though the Ice Breakers have not scored while shorthanded since mid-November.

ELITE UNITS: Port Huron has arguably has the best overall special teams in the league with a top-ranked power play unit (28.6 percent) to pair with a relentless penalty kill (84.0 percent). This weekend's matchup will see two of the top three penalty kill units do battle.

ICE BREAKER KILLER: **F Zachary Zulkanycz** seems to have the Ice Breakers' number dating back to last season. He already has three goals in three games against Mentor this year and scored 10 times while racking up 16 assists for 26 points in 11 games against the Ice Breakers last season.
