ICE BREAKERS PRE-SCOUT: The Ice Breakers lost four of six on a lengthy road trip before logging a two-game sweep in a home-and-home series against Battle Creek. Last weekend, Mentor fell to Carolina on back-to-back nights at Mentor Ice Arena. With 33 points and a record of 11-9-0-0, Mentor is in fourth place in the Eastern Division and sixth in the FPHL. Mentor is led in scoring by **F Jon Buttitta** (18-20-38), **F Declan Conway** (20-17-37), and **D Brody Duncan** (5-11-16).

HAT TRICKS PRE-SCOUT: The Hat Tricks are riding high with an 11-game winning streak. Danbury is coming off a four-game, two-weekend sweep of the former Eastern Division leaders, the Watertown Wolves. The Tricks are in first place in the Eastern Division and second in the 10-team FPHL. Danbury's top scorers are **F Jonny Ruiz** (14-14-28), **F Gordy Bonnel** (5-21-26), and **F Nicola Levesque** (10-15-25).

SEASON SERIES: Tonight marks the first of three matchups between the Ice Breakers and Hat Tricks and the only contest at Mentor Ice Arena. Despite being division rivals, Mentor and Danbury play a very limited season series. From March 20-21, the Ice Breakers will travel to Connecticut to play a two-game set against the Hat Tricks at Danbury Ice Arena.

The Ice Breakers continue their six-game holiday homestand with a two-game series against the Port Huron Prowlers. All fans are invited to a postgame skate with the players following the action, with rental skates available for \$3.00 in the lobby.

WEEK IN REVIEW: Last at home, the Ice Breakers were defeated by the Carolina Thunderbirds, 5-1. Mentor scored first at 6:36 of the second frame when **D Brody Duncan** found twine, breaking open what had been a tightly contested matchup. The Thunderbirds answered with a pair of goals over a span of less than a minute before striking three times in the final period to take home the series-opening win.

Saturday's game saw the return of **G Austyn Roudebush**, who stopped 29 of 31 shots but fell to 9-7-0-0 after the Ice Breakers suffered a 2-1 loss. Carolina scored at 15:40 of the first period before going up 2-0 late in the second period on a goal by **F Daniel Martin**. **F Declan Conway** scored the lone Mentor tally at 4:24 of the final frame on a feed from linemate **F Jon Buttitta**.

STILL RECOVERING: Mentor's prized trade acquisition, **D Jiri Pestuka**, was unavailable for last weekend's series against Carolina. The Czech Republic native's status remains unclear for this week's contests. His presence will certainly boost the Ice Breakers upon his return. **F Chad Herron**, who was added along with Pestuka in a swap with the Columbus River Dragons, made his Ice Breakers debut last Saturday.

SHUTTING THEM DOWN: Currently operating at an 85.9 percent clip, the Ice Breakers' penalty kill is second-best in the FPHL, trailing only Carolina (90.5 percent). Mentor is tied with Columbus with seven shorthanded goals on the year, though the Ice Breakers have not scored while shorthanded since mid-November.

BACK IN ACTION: **G Austyn Roudebush** was back between the pipes on Saturday night following a two-week absence due to injury. He delivered a fantastic performance against Carolina's league-best offense in a 2-1 loss, stopping 29 of 31 shots (.935 SV%). On Carolina's first goal, Roudebush's skate blade fell off, forcing the Toledo, Ohio, product to the locker room for repairs with less than five minutes left in the opening period.

G Jordan Brant filled in admirably during Roudebush's two-week absence, compiling a 2.98 goals-against average and .902 save percentage. Brant is expected to return to a backup role as Roudebush reclaims his spot as Mentor's workhorse.

STREAKS HALTED: It took the top defensive team in the FPHL to end the 16-game point streak of **F Declan Conway**, who is leading the league in goals (20). During the streak, which dated to November 1, Conway collected 18 goals and 17 assists for a total of 35 points. He also put together a stretch of 13 goals in eight games from November 23 to December 14.

League-leading scorer **F Jon Buttitta** (18-20-38) had a lengthy point streak of his own snapped on Friday night. Buttitta had registered at least a point in 14 straight contests, including three games with at least four points.

SURPRISING STAT: For all the success Danbury has had in its inaugural campaign, it has had a significant weak spot. The Hat Tricks are killing off only 75 percent of penalties against them, ninth-best in the FPHL and ahead of only the winless Battle Creek Rumble Bees. Danbury's penalty kill and Mentor's power play will be an interesting matchup to watch as both units have struggled.

CONSISTENT PERFORMER: **F Cory Anderson** is the only Hat Trick to record at least a point in every game during the club's current winning streak. Anderson, who has seven goals and seven assists during the streak, has a 12-9-21 scoring line over 19 appearances.
