In recognition of the media coverage of the Kansas City Supernovas and applicants there to, the undersigned grants the Kansas City Comets, the Major Arena Soccer League and its licensees her permission and authority to use her name, voice, picture, and likeness in connection with any and all publications, media, broadcasts, promotional photographs, promotional posters, commercial products, including but not limited to calendars, team pictures, T-shirts, and any other commercial items with no further compensation to applicant.

This information will be used to evaluate the undersigned as an applicant for employment and, if hired, for any other employment purpose. The undersigned further authorizes any person, entity or agency contacted by the Kansas City Comets or its authorized agents to furnish the above-mentioned information. If a background check reveals that the undersigned has provided inaccurate information or omitted information on the Kansas City Supernovas application, then it may result in the rejection of her application or, if already employed, in the termination of her employment.
