Meeting called to order at 6:37 by Les Moore

2024 AGM Meeting Minutes – Motion to approve by Dave, Becky 2<sup>nd</sup>, minutes approved.

### Election of new and returning members overseen by Karen Bingham as Parliamentarian

- Dave Rounds – Returning member; motion carried
- Jon Redinbo – Returning member; motion carried
- Rudy Chavez – Returning member; motion carried

### Ken Ogdgen – New Board member nominated by Les Moore

- We got to know Ken with some questions relating to his desire to be a part of the Board.
- The Board discussed some of the difficulties we have faced recently with format changes, and how we are looking to overcome these difficulties.
- Motion carried for Ken to join the Board of Directors, and Ken was welcomed in.
- Karen will set him up in the GotSport system to do the background check and necessary classes.
- The 2025 Board will consist of 7 members

### Registrar update by Karen:

- The boys' competitive contracts were sent again including the incomplete registrations.
- Registration lists will be sent to the coaches.
- The rosters were built in Got Sport to make it simple when they accept the contract.
- Most of the incomplete contracts are due to not initialing the concussion and waivers.
- There are approximately 35-38 incomplete contracts.
- We will be able to start background checks on July 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Jon was asked to add a registration link on the website for the Fall Recreation Season.

### President's Report:

- The 24-25 competitive season had a lot of turnovers in administration. Several Board Members and coaches left the club.
- The new Board seems to work together well.
- Season comparisons:
  - Fall Recreation season of 2023 - 623 kids
  - Fall Recreation season of 2024 - 458 kids
  - Spring Recreation season of 2024 - 441 kids
  - Spring Recreation season of 2025 - 328 kids
  - Competitive Season of 23-24 we had 275 players with 18 teams; 579 signed up for try-outs.
  - Competitive Season of 24-25 to date we have created 15 teams with between 230-240 players; 475 signed up for try-outs.
- Polk County is struggling as it relates to the girls' teams.
  - We have 5 girls' teams for the 25-26 Competitive Season.
  - Tropics is the only club with a U19 Girls team.
  - Older girls seem to be focusing on other sports.
- We are increasing in younger players but losing older players. We are making two 2015 boy's teams.
- We will have access to 5 new turf fields after July 1<sup>st</sup>.
- We attended the opening ceremony for the turf fields with our new logo.
  - We purchased 8 goals which are at the turf fields but have not been assembled: four U12 and four U10 goals. The county will reimburse us the cost of \$3280 by deducting it from our Spring payment.
  - The county supplied full size goals for the turf fields.
  - Our keys do not work on the concession or new bathrooms. The old bathrooms are not locked.
  - We will be sharing the turf fields with football and adult soccer league.

### Revenue:

- We had approximately a \$20k increase in revenue compared to prior year.
- Currently we have approximately \$161K in bank, and bills are paid.

### Competitive Season Results:

- Overall, we had about 7-8 competitive teams that went to Charlotte for playoffs.
- The 2011 boys' team was accepted to play in FSPL this year.
- The 2015 boys team won USA group they were in.
- The 2008 boys started the season out slow. They improved after break.
- Dave had a U9 team they won 4 tied 3 lost 7. They never gave up more than 5 goals.
- Rudy's team grew as the season progressed.
- The 2011 Girls had a difficult season. It was a rebuild year, and the team was outmatched with several teams on the schedule due to the North/South divisions.

### Misc. Topics

- Rudy discussed incentive for teams to receive incentives for volunteering outside of their teams.
- We will need to discuss how to move forward with Spring as the format used the last two seasons were not successful.
- Jamboree can include celebration of our rebranding on 9/6/25 with Fall season starting 9/13/25.
- Glory Days will be hosting our coach gathering in August.
- We must have a board member present at each set of fields on practice nights. Les will figure it in when he maps fields.
- We will be updating domain names.
- Late registration will begin 8/11/25 for Fall Rec.
- Look into Epic Sports for Forza style goals at a reasonable price.
- We have \$1610 in FYSA Bucks to use by 7/1/25. We will likely order balls, cones, and benches.
