



Anti-Doping Policy

Policy Statement

Ontario Baseball Association (OBA) is committed to the principles of ethical, fair, and doping-free sport and supports a sport system that upholds integrity, athlete health, and public confidence.

OBA adopts the **Canadian Policy Against Doping in Sport** as its anti-doping policy framework and supports the principles of the **Canadian Anti-Doping Program (CADP)** and the **World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) Code**.

Scope and Application

This policy applies to all athletes, coaches, officials, volunteers, and other participants involved in OBA-sanctioned programs and activities, to the extent of OBA's authority as a Provincial Sport Organization.

Role and Responsibilities

Ontario Baseball Association **does not conduct drug testing or anti-doping control activities**.

Drug testing, results management, therapeutic use exemptions, and sanctions for anti-doping rule violations are administered by **Sport Integrity Canada** under the Canadian Anti-Doping Program and, where applicable, by **Baseball Canada** at the national level.

OBA's role is limited to:

- Supporting and promoting awareness of the Canadian anti-doping framework
- Ensuring that its programs and services do not conflict with the CADP or the WADA Code
- Cooperating with Baseball Canada and Sport Integrity Canada where required
- Respecting and enforcing any sanctions imposed under the Canadian Anti-Doping Program that apply to participants within OBA's jurisdiction

Alignment with National and International Standards

The Canadian Anti-Doping Program is compliant with the World Anti-Doping Code and its associated International Standards. Any amendments to the CADP or the WADA Code are automatically recognized and applied under this policy.

Administration

This policy will be reviewed periodically to ensure continued alignment with national anti-doping standards and the policies of Baseball Canada. Questions regarding anti-doping matters may be directed to the OBA office or to Sport Integrity Canada, as appropriate.
