23 teams
Three countries
Our 2nd Season



In just its second ever season of play, Major Arena Soccer League Women has mushroomed to 24 teams, including 18 teams returning from the league's inaugural season, and six new clubs, representing teams in Canada, the United States and Mexico. It is only the second time ever in the MASL pyramid of that all three countries in North America have been represented under the MASL banner.



Three of the teams in the Great Lakes North – Detroit City FC, Indiana United at the Youngstown Nighthawks were members last year. Detroit City, in fact, turned in a perfect 10-0 season and advanced to the league's first-ever championship game, where they fell to the Chihuahua Savage. New in the GLN is a Canadian entry, FC Berlin, which is based in Kitchener, Ontario Canada.

Many eyes will be on the Great Lakes South, where all four teams finished with better than .500 records last season. That includes the Cincinnati Sirens who won the regular season with an 8-2 record. Nipping at their heels all season were the Louisville Triumph, Columbus Eagles, and Akron based Susserfuss Ballveiren, who all return.

The Heartland five teams returning, including all three based in one of most iconic indoor soccer markets in the country, Wichita. The ICT Aztecs were the regular season division winners in 2024-25, and they are joined again this year by the Wichita Aero and Wichita Lady Luck, sister team to the MASL 2 Wichita

Wings. Also back is the Side FC Cyclones (OKC Oblivion last season) and the Tulsa FC Channel Cats, joined by a second Oklahoma City area team this winter, the OKC Ghosts.

Teams will play a 10-game regular season schedule with a national playoffs to conclude the season next spring at a site to be determined.

>> PREVIOUS MEETINGS: This is the first meeting of the season between the two teams.

>> GAME NOTES: The Queens come in with a record of 2-0, the exact same record as the Demon Hawks. Iowa has scored 21 goals in those two games, and given up just three while Omaha has scored 20 goals and given up just six, so this figures to be a dandy matchup. Although both were in the league last season, they played in different divisions so they did not play each other in 2024-25.

>>> PLAYERS TO WATCH: Iowa has added some of the top talent from MASL W last year including Valeria Macias who played with the champion Chihuahua Savage in 2024-25. She is the club leader in goals this year with seven after scoring 13 goals and totaling 27 points last season. Silvia "Azee" Castillo is the team's leading scorer with six goals and three assists so far ... For Omaha, Mia Hurt has been the big offensive threat with six goals. Erionelle Cliffton and Tori Von Mende have each added two goals and two assists.

>> PREVIOUS MEETINGS: This is the first meeting of the season between the two teams.

>> GAME NOTES: This weekend marks the Monterrey debut, although the city is no stranger to the indoor game with Monterrey playing several seasons of MASL soccer. Houston comes to town with a mark of 1-1 with a goal differential of minus 7 with 12 goals scored and 19 given up. Their win was a 7-5 season opening triumph over Austin 512 FC.

>> PLAYERS TO WATCH: Houston has three different players with two goals each so far this winter: Nicole Henry, Allie Byrd and Rebekah O'Brien. Henry had seven points in eight games for the Bolts last year. O'Brien had eight points in seven games in 2024-25.

>> PREVIOUS MEETINGS: These two team met in late December in Austin with the home team winning 7-5. This was pretty tight throughout as neither team held more than a two-goal lead at any point on the contest, with Austin 512 FC (1-1) scoring their first win of the season. HIC had an early two-goal lead, but Austin took the lead for good midway through the third on a goal from Karen Esparza. After falling behind 2-0, Austin scored five of the game's next six goals. Twice HIC got it back to within one in the second half, but never

found an equalizer. Houston got some much needed offense from Sally Palmier, who had a hat trick. HIC had come in having scored just three goals in its first two games. Three players had multipoint games for 512 FC including Ryan Jergovich who scored twice and Jaycie Bass and Esparza who each had a goal and one assist. Amanda Lisberger got the win in net.

» **GAME NOTES:** On the season, Houston comes in with a mark of 1-1 with 12 goals scored while allowing 19. Austin is 1-3, but doesn't have a bad goal differential of just minus 7 with 23 goals scored and 30 allowed. Houston won the two starts between the two last year, 17-0 and 11-5.

» **PLAYERS TO WATCH:** Jaycie Bass is second on the team in scoring after playing last season for San Antonio. She has four goals and one assist to date. Austin's leading scorer is Arianni Hudge with five goals and one assist, including a hat trick in the win over Houston ... The Bolt's most productive scorer has been Sally Palmier, who has only played one of the two games for her team so far, as she had a hat trick against Austin in their first meeting.

» **PREVIOUS MEETINGS:** This is the second meeting of the season as Louisville took a 10-4 win over the Akron based team back on December 6. Susserfuss took a 2-1 lead in the final minute of the first quarter on a goal by McKenna Donahue, but the Triumph scored the next six goals in the game to build a comfortable edge. Brielle Heuglin got what proved to be the game winner just 12 seconds before the half, part of a three-point effort with two goals and one assist. Erin Yenney made her 2025-26 debut one to remember with a hat trick, while Lindsey Robbins chipped in with a goal and one assist. Delayna Holman got the win in nets. Halle Stelbasky led the way for Susserfuss (0-1) with a goal and one assist.

» **GAME NOTES:** Louisville is off to a great start at 5-0, with a goal differential of plus 19 with 28 goals scored and just nine allowed. Susserfuss, conversely, has struggled at the start of 2025-26 and is 0-2 with seven goals scored and 16 allowed. Louisville took a pair from Susserfuss in the 2024-25 season by scores of 8-5 and 8-3 on the Triumph's home

field.

» **PLAYERS TO WATCH:** Emma Nicholson is Louisville's top goal getter with five goals in three games to go along with one assist. Brielle Heuglin has four goals in three games and Lindsey Robbins has three goals and two assists. For Susserfuss, Alexa Langenfield is the only player with more than one goal on the season as she has scored twice and added one assist.

» **PREVIOUS MEETINGS:** These two teams met last weekend in OKC, with the Lady Luck picking up a hard fought 9-6 win. The OKC Ghosts continue to play good soccer for a first-year club, and gave the Luck a scare before falling at home. Wichita, who was 8-1-1 last year, built a 5-2 lead only to see the Ghosts reel off three straight, the last by Emily Tincher to forge a 5-5 tie. But OKC never could grab the lead, and Wichita showed its pedigree late to pull away. Caleigh Carpenter, Evelyn Filbeck and Anjaleena Gomez each scored twice to pace the visitor's attack. Abigail McCulloch got credit for the win in goal. Tincher had two for the Ghosts as did Kira Copeland. Joanni Thomas and Caitlyn Hirst had two assists each for OKC as well.

» **GAME NOTES:** The Ghosts come in with a record of 0-4 with 22 goals scored and 44 against so far. In addition to their close loss last weekend, they have a two-goal defeat on the road to the Wichita Aero as well. The Lady Luck, who were 8-1-1 last season, come in at 3-2 with a plus one goal differential, scoring 22 but only giving up 21.

» **PLAYERS TO WATCH:** OKC has gotten nice production from Caitlyn Hirst who has four goals and three assists so far this year. Ireland McKibbon and Kira Copeland have also been contributing. McKibbon has two goals and three assists while Copeland has four goals and two assists ... Caleigh Carpenter leads Wichita with four goals. She also has one assist ... Emily Kolbe has been another offensive leader so far for the Luck with two goals and three assists. It has been a balanced attack with six different players having scored at least two goals on the season.

ICT has two other five goal scorers season to date in Dora Gallo and Makayla Morgan.
