Summary

The Director of Ticket Sales, under the direction of the General Manager, is responsible for all team ticket-related services including season and group sales, customer service functions, database management, supervision of the ticket sales department, and the execution of organizational objectives to achieve sales-related goals.

- Implement and oversee the management of the ticket operating system (AXS) for season, group, and single-game ticket packages to maximize revenue generation.
