Most Valuable Player - This honor is typically bestowed upon the best performing player during the regular season. This player will be considered the best performing player of any position. Voting will be based on many factors such as but not limited to, points, dominating play, play making ability, Hockey IQ, and other intangibles that make them stand out as the best player in the league.

Top Goaltender – Presented to the league's most outstanding goaltender, this award recognizes exceptional skill, consistency, and performance throughout the season. The recipient demonstrates strong save ability, composure under pressure, and plays a key role in their team's success while setting the standard for excellence in net

Top Defencemen – Awarded to the best performing defensive player who demonstrates throughout the season the greatest all-round ability to defend. This player will excel in defensive play in all areas of the ice, provide physical play, exceptional back checking and other intangibles related to defence. They shall also possess an offensive prowess.

Sportsmanship Award – This Honor is typically bestowed upon the player who most exemplifies the ideals of sportsmanship. This recipient will lead by example and excel in the commitment to fair play, ethical behavior and integrity on the ice. While the only stat to measure sportsmanship is penalty minutes the award relies on nominations.

Rookie of the Year – This award is given to the most proficient player in their first year. This player will excel in ways that are beneficial to the success of their team. This recipient must have played 50 percent of their team's games and will be voted on by their overall stats, skills, abilities and nominations.

Wendy Hurley Volunteer Award – This award is in honor of late Wendy Hurley who co-founded Noralta Junior hockey and volunteered countless hours. The award is given to a chosen individual who has made an outstanding contribution during the current season. Any team or league official, administrator and manager are eligible to win this award.

John Koyko Leadership – This award recognizes an individual as a superior leader. Must show an advanced ability to motivate and inspire others, to lead by example and make important decisions in high pressure situations. Bringing a team together can be the difference between winning and losing. This award is named after a long-time leader in our community and league John Koyko who is no longer with us.
