# **GAME DAY PROTOCOL COVID 19 SAFETY PLAN OUTLINE**

#### **PURPOSE:**

To safely return players to practices and games during COVID 19 pandemic under the guidance of the Governor of Washington, Sporting Activities COVID-19 Requirements, Updated 2.11.2021. This is to comply with requirements of our league and association.

Return to play action plan and reporting safety procedures for reporting concerns and symptoms will not supersede Lewis County, Thurston County and State requirements. It may amended as new directives are made available.

## PARENTS AND SPECTATORS GUIDELINES:

We have zero tolerance for players and parents not following the guidelines in this document.

All attending the game or practice (parents and players) will ensure that they don't have a temperature 100.3 and above. They must inform the coach and not show up to the event. No exemptions.

Parents and players should bring extra sanitizer and masks.

Please utilize bathroom prior to the event there are no access to toilets.

Bring extra water. All players must stay hydrate all throughout the game and practice.

Facial coverings required for all spectators, parents, coaches, volunteers and athletes at all times.

All spectators will wear masks at all times and practice 6 feet social distance when they are outside their vehicles. It is recommended that everyone stay in their vehicles.

All spectators of different households are to remain physically distant, 6 feet or more, as much as possible

Outdoor training, practices and competitions a maximum 200 people allowed at competitions, including spectators.

For outdoor competitions; for facilities or complexes with more than one field or area of play a maximum of 75 people allowed per field or area of play, including spectators.

For all indoor sports the occupancy of the facility may not exceed 25 percent of the fire code occupancy rating, or 200 people including spectators, whichever is lower.

#### **BEFORE GAME START:**

Only one (1) parent or guardian per player is allowed to attend the game on the sidelines.

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Players should practice social distance with other players.

## WHILE PLAYING:

Players (coaches, staff, and volunteers) must wear mask while playing and practice social distancing while at the bench or sideline.

Any players (coaches, staff, volunteers) showing symptoms of illness will be removed from the game.

# **AFTER THE GAME:**

Spectators should depart the field area as soon as possible and must wear the mask until they have reached social distance.

Players and parents (coaches, staff, and volunteers) should allow visiting team and spectators to depart first to avoid congestion and allow for proper social distancing.

Players are recommended to go directly home and conduct personal hygiene prior to any other activities.

### **COVID-19 POSITIVE TEST ACTION PLAN:**

Director of Coaching or Director of Operations (see below for contact number) will be the point of contact in the event of a player is exposed to COVID-19

Players from either team that has a positive test within 14 days after the game, either the coach, Director of Coaching, Director of Operations will notify the opposing coach and follow all club, league, associations and State guidelines, procedures and protocols.

### **INCLIMENT WEATHER ACTION PLAN:**

Players/parents should be prepared for rain, and have plastic bags to protect their backpack and personal belongings.

Coaches will notify parents and players in the event practice or game is cancelled.

In the event there are delays due to weather, all players are required to go back in their cars and wait for further guidance from the coaches.
