Your Role as Team Manager

The Team Manager acts as the primary liaison between the coach, families, players, and the SC Wave administrative team. You'll help keep the team organized, informed, and running efficiently.

While some duties may be delegated to other parents, your main responsibilities include:

Communication

- Be the central contact point for all non-coaching matters.
- Direct questions about player selection, positions, or playing time to the coach. Please do not interpret or explain coach decisions—encourage families to speak with the coach directly.

Scheduling & Team Updates

- Send out practice schedules, game information, and other announcements.
- Use PlayMetrics and email for communication.
- For teams U16 and older, please also email players directly as they may drive themselves.

Game Day & Team Administration

- Keep organized records including team rosters, player passes (if applicable), match cards, referee fee envelopes, and game scores.
(Note: Player passes are not required for U10 and under, or for State League and SECL teams.)

Match Day Reports

- Print game day documents (rosters, match cards).
- Submit final scores as required by your league. Your coach will help guide you.

Tips for Successful Management

- Be approachable and respectful—listening can often be the best solution.
- Maintain confidentiality—treat private information with care.
- Encourage parent involvement by asking for volunteers.
- Handle issues privately, not in public.
- Support the coach by letting them lead all coaching decisions.
- Be consistent and fair in your dealings with families.

Player Requirements

Player Registration

- Players register online at www.scwave.org.
- New players create an account; returning players update theirs.

Refunds

- SC Wave has a no refund policy. Requests go to the Executive Director.
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Player Passes

When Passes Are Not Required:

- Players U10 and younger
- State League and SECL teams
- Recreational teams
- GA and MLS NEXT players

When Passes May Be Required:

- Out-of-state tournaments
- Certain regional or national competitions

If required, reach out to the Registrar and she will submit the request to have player passes produced. Please request your player passes a minimum of one week prior to needing them. Always ensure you have all player cards before leaving games or tournaments. Replacement card costs are team responsibility.

Club Passed Players

- Must be rostered with SC Wave.
- Require a copy of their home team roster.
- Follow league or tournament rules on eligibility and quantity.
- Visit the WYSA website for details.

Risk Management & Coaching Passes

- Coaches and assistants must complete WYSA Risk Management.
 - Managers only need a pass if the coach requests them on the sideline.
 - Coaching passes are now downloaded and printed by coaches.

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Team Finances

- Teams pay their own seasonal expenses (extra tournaments, coach travel, training).
 - Maintain a team budget and payment records.
 - Notify the Coach if families fall behind on their team payments.
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Coach Expenses

Out-of-Town Tournaments & Weekends:

- Team pays coach hotel fees
- Mileage: \$50 per 100 miles driven
- Airfare/ car rental if needed
- Per diem: \$50/day

Extra Tournaments:

- Same travel costs plus \$50/game coaching fee

Off-Season Training:

- \$35 per game/session (indoor, futsal, training)

Payments go directly from manager to coach.

League Play

- Coach will guide you on league rules, scheduling, and procedures.
- Print rosters and match cards as required.
- Submit game results promptly.

Referee Payments

- Each team pays half the referee fees before each game.
 - Request funds after schedules are posted by emailing: shana@rocventures.org
Include your name, address, team name, league, and amount requested.
 - Site directors may distribute cash in some locations.
 - Only pay referees who show up. Return any unused funds to Shan Amini.
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Tournaments

Club-Covered Tournaments:

- Register online, choose "Pay by check," and send confirmation to the Executive Director.
- Club will pay after confirming registrations.

Additional Tournaments:

- Teams pay directly unless told otherwise. Ask about discounts.

Travel Requirements:

- Complete WYSA Notification to Travel for out-of-state events.
- Stay-to-Play hotels must be used to avoid disqualification.
- Don't buy airfare until registration is confirmed.
